**PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY:**

- Current pay is \$20.00 per hour with holiday pay if work shift falls on holiday.
- All applicants must be a U.S. Citizen, 18 years of age or older
- Have not been convicted of a violation of criminal law including domestic violence. Criminal law generally includes all offenses except traffic law, conservation law and liquor law. Generally, conviction for a violation of criminal law is automatically disqualifying.
- The applicant must be able to work a variety of shifts including holidays and weekends.
- The applicant must have a Strong Moral and Ethic Base and have a Passion for Community Policing and Public Service.

- Application
- Resume
- Valid driver's license with photo
- Proof of police academy enrollment with date of graduation

**NOTE:** Applicants must apply in person with all required original documents (candidates must provide copies of all documents).

**BACKGROUND CHECK:**

A rigid, on-going background check will be conducted on successful candidates.

**QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF HIRE**

Applicant must meet one of the following requirements:

- Proof of police academy graduation and licensed/licensable MCOLES
- 2 years of out-of-state experience with MCOLES license
