If you can help the Las Vegas Iowa Club and willing to do so, please consider these volunteer support activities to help the Club be the absolute best that we can be.

Logistics game watch set up and arrangements- This vital helper inflates Herky, displays flags, sets up speaker and microphone. Disassembles and puts everything away at the end of the program. Time: approximately 1 hour before the game watch and 15 minutes after. Helpful volunteer may sign up for individual, or multiple game watches. This is a team effort.

Newsletter contributor: Provide news, pictures, relevant quotes, members' comments, and general feedback; Time: approximately 2 hour or less per month.

Social Media assistant: Serve as an admin to review, coordinate with Board Chair reliable material to post, fresh ideas. Time: 1 hour a month

Graphics Art contributor: Provide artwork, including photos from Club events, university occasions, sporting news and other prospective information for the newsletter, as well as flyers, and game watch location displays. Time: Less than an hour a month

Fundraising Chair: Lead concepts for fundraising, using the social media and newsletter, as well as game watches for promotion. One large project or several smaller ideas. Time: 1 hour a month

T Shirt sales assistant: Assist with coordination of ordering merchandise, inventory, and sales by mail, or in person at game watches. Design. New ideas. Time: Approximately 1 hour a month.

Raffle prize and ticket assistant: Distribution sales of 50/50 tickets at game watches and prize choices for the game watch raffles. Time: Sign up for selling at a game watch. Not required to participate at every game. Can share the responsibility.

Community outreach coordinator and assistant: Join efforts with another Big Ten Club to plan at least one combined event each year. Select a charitable benefactor, such as Project 150, to volunteer supportive time on behalf of the Club. Time: 2 hours a month

Web administrator: Monitor and maintain the Club's current web design. Time: As needed usually less than 1 hour per month.

Web contributor: Conceptual idea overseer to attract viewers to the Club website, including overall fans of the Hawkeye nation. Time: 1 hour a month.

Team "boots on the ground" makes these vital tasks much speedier and easy to do. Spirited volunteers can continue to enjoy the game watches and cheer our University of Iowa Hawkeyes. Please consider offering to help where you can do so.
