GGA UNIFORMS GUIDELINES

Here's what you'll need to know to get your children "dressed for success" in time for Back-to-School. Students in all grades must wear uniforms

Polo Shirts: Maroon, Gray, Navy Blue, (Short sleeved shirts with collars)

Bottoms: Khaki or Black: Trouser, Shorts, Skorts, Skirts

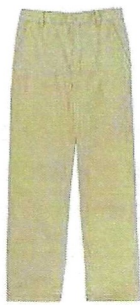

Trouser pants must fit well and not be oversized or undersized. Pants must fit at the waist and must not sag. Uniform pants must be straight-legged, and pockets must be the standard front pockets. No "baggies" or loose-fit pants are permitted.

Shorts, Skorts, Skirts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.

No visible drawstrings on pants, skort, shorts or thin skirts. All clothing must be hemmed. No cut-offs, side cuts or rolled-up cuff. Cuff must be tailored and tacked/sewn at the seams.

Student wearing uniforms must conform to all other dress code requirements as outlined in the GGA Parent/Student Handbook.





Dress Code and Personal Appearance

At George Gervin Academy we believe uniforms unify us. It eliminates social economic anxiety and allows us to focus on what matters the most, academics. Students must be in uniform while on campus, including school functions, clubs, field trips, etc. unless authorized or approved by administration.

All students should be well-groomed to prepare them for future boardrooms and businesses they will lead one day. **Shirt must be neatly tucked into bottoms and buttoned up, with pants at waist and a black belt.**

Unacceptable Appearance Items:

- Cargo Pants/Shorts
- T-Shirts
- Joggers
- Hairstyles that will inhibit learning environment
- (e.g., Mohawks, Spiked Hair, etc.)
- Headwear shall not be worn in buildings (unless worn for legitimate religious purposes)
- Hoodies, Sweatshirts, Ski Masks
- Leggings, Spandex, Bicycle Pants, Tight or Revealing
- Clothing
- Oversized or Sagging Clothes
- Tank Tops, Muscle Shirts, Halter Tops, Spaghetti Straps. Exposed Back or Midriffs, and any See-Through Garments
- Indecent/Inappropriate clothing, Writing or Patches (e.g., Alcohol, Sex, Tobacco, drugs, Gang, Gang Related, etc.)
- Sandals, Crocs, slides, House Shoes etc.
- Cut-Off or rolled-Up Clothing or Cuffed Items
- Hats, Caps, Do-Rags, Bandanas, etc.

Dress Code Violations

All George Gervin Academy Students must follow a mandated uniform policy. Students who violate dress code will be given the opportunity to correct problem if occurrence is the first offense. If Dress Code infractions continue, students will be assigned appropriate discipline consequences outlined in Student Code of Conduct. Repeated dress code offenses may result in more serious disciplinary action and may constitute a Level I or Level II offense. Appropriate Discipline procedures shall be followed
