Basically, what you are telling me is the city received a statement letter from an engineer with no reference number of what it pertains to, and the city has not reviewed it giving it its stamp of approval as is the city's normal protocol with all engineering letters and reports? Even statement letters I have received from the city of Miami beach under PRR regarding violations (SEE ATTACHED) have a violation number and special magistrate number for reference. It is inconceivable to think after the surfside tragedy that the City of Miami Beach would receive a statement letter regarding the columns which are the lifeline to our building from an engineer with no reference /permit number to apply it to.

If a disaster like surfside occurs in our building the engineer and the City Of Miami beach can very well claim that this letter of final inspection refers to a permit that was obtained for concrete restoration that was conducted around windows. Please provide me with the official engineering letter stamped by the city that the letter you are providing relates to RV2217866. Thank you
