

Northshore Charter School Discipline Plan

Infractions are categorized into levels

- Level 0 Minor infractions handled by classroom teachers
 Minor infractions are documented on the Classroom
 Discipline Ladder
- Level 1 Minor infractions upgraded to an Office Referral
- Level 2 Major infractions requiring an Office Referral
- Level 3 Major infractions requiring an Office Referral

Infractions are assigned demerits and possible consequences Refer to NCS Student Handbook

100 Total Demerits will result in a Discipline Hearing.
