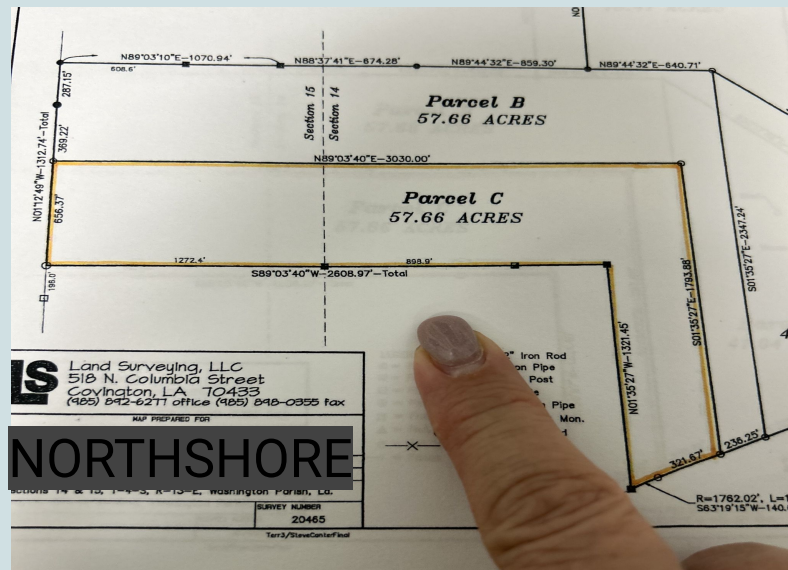

### Northshore Charter School Discipline Plan

Infractions are categorized into levels

Level 0 - Minor infractions handled by classroom teachers

Minor infractions are documented on the Classroom Discipline Ladder

Level 1 - Minor infractions upgraded to an Office Referral

Level 2 - Major infractions requiring an Office Referral

Level 3 - Major infractions requiring an Office Referral

Infractions are assigned demerits and possible consequences

Refer to NCS Student Handbook

100 Total Demerits will result in a Discipline Hearing.
