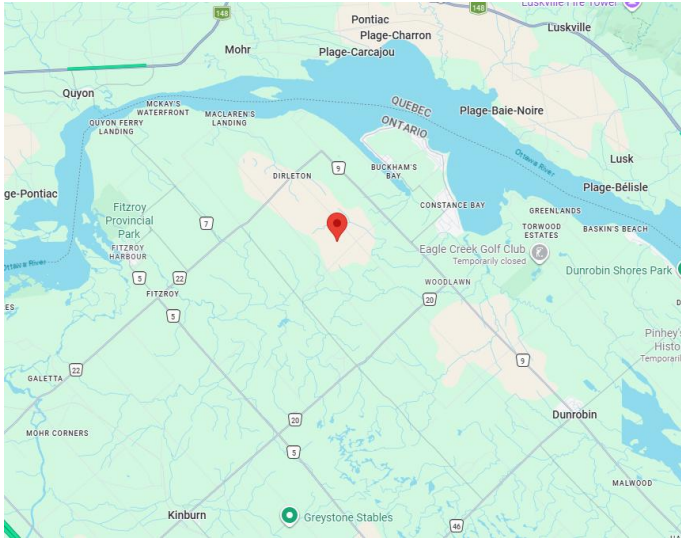
**Trial Entry and Payment (e-transfer only):** You will receive an email copy of your registration form. You will receive a separate confirmation email and invoice when your entry is accepted. Please send payment after you receive your confirmation email – payment instructions are below and in your confirmation email. If payment is not received within 7 days of invoice, your entry will be suspended; and may not guarantee participation in the trial. If payment is not received by the closing date, your registration will be cancelled.

**Payment:** Via e-transfer to [trials@capsagility.ca](mailto:trials@capsagility.ca) (Security word, if required, is **CAPS**). Please indicate your dog's AAC ID # in the message section and that your payment is for the May-31, 2026 AAC Trial. If you cannot pay via e-transfer, please indicate this in the notes section of your registration form and we will find a way to make it work.

- **From Ottawa:** From Ottawa take the 417 (heading west towards Arnprior), at the Kinburn Side Road exit and go north-east on Kinburn Side Road (Regional Road 20) for approximately 15km. Turn left at Woodkilton Rd, continue approximately 3.6km, through Kilmaurs, turn left at the 2<sup>nd</sup> laneway (just past the spruce trees) (4357 Woodkilton Road). Follow the signs to the field past the barn.
- **From Kanata:** From the 417 take Exit 138 Hwy 49/March Rd North for approximately 8.0 km to traffic lights at Dunrobin Rd. Turn right; continue on Dunrobin Rd for 13.5km. Turn left at the ESSO onto Kinburn Side Road. In 1.4km, turn right onto Woodkilton Rd. continue approximately 3.6km, through Kilmaurs, turn left at the 2<sup>nd</sup> laneway (just past the spruce trees) (4357 Woodkilton Road).
- **From Arnprior:** From Hwy 29, turn right onto ON-17 (Madawaska Blvd), 3.7km turn left onto Galetta Side Rd/Ottawa Regional Rd 22 (signs for Galetta/Ottawa Road 22/Galetta Side Road), 14.6 km turn right onto Woodkilton Road, in 2.7km the venue is on your right (4357 Woodkilton Road)

## **General Information:**

**Trial Format:** Regular format outdoor field.

**Classes:** Regular, Special and Veterans classes will be offered as required. Junior Handler Classes will be available.

**Safety Protocols:** While specific, strict, nationwide COVID-19 mandates may have changed, competitors, volunteers, and general public while attending CAPS trials must follow all local and provincial government public health guidelines, which may include measures for sanitization and, if necessary, social distancing.

**Move-ups:** Move-ups will be allowed during the trial, provided space, time and sequence of events allow.

**Accessibility Option:** Accessibility option with concessions for seniors (65 years and older) or handlers with disabilities, may request a modified course time and a modified point requirement. A handler must indicate on the entry form if entering as a senior/AO handler (check AO box) to receive modified times/reduced number of points required to qualify.

**Dog Collars:** Dog will be allowed to wear a close-fitting collar, with no attachments.

**Obstacles:** Flexible Tunnels, Saloon-door style Tire Jump, winged Panel Jump, Winged Double Bar Jump, Wall Jump, Winged Single Bar Jumps, Weaves, Dogwalk (unslatted), A-frame (slatted), and Teeter.

**Facilities:** The trial will be held outdoors on grass, in a 100x120ft fully fenced field. Porta-potty is available. There are acres of land to walk your dog on a leash during the trial, you do so at your own risk. The perimeter of the farm is not fenced. We do not have an off-leash area, dogs must be leashed at all times. We ask that you potty your dog away from the house or buildings, we have other dogs and their space should be respected. We do ask that you poop-n-scoop, pails will be available to deposit your poop bags only. Please keep your dog on a leash unless in a car, in a crate or some other means of containment or running an event.

The house, farm buildings and equipment are off limits. Please do not allow your dog(s) to relieve themselves on any of the farm structures or equipment, in or around the barnyard.

Dogs are not permitted anywhere near the livestock.

**Dog Aggression:** All dogs must be kept in an X-pen, crate, in your car, or on leash when on CAPS property, and not in the ring. Note that the use of retractable leashes is not permitted on CAPS property. To avoid incidents of dog aggression towards other dogs and/or people, please give all dogs lots of room, and be aware of your dog's behaviour. Any dog engaging in aggressive behaviour at any time will be required to leave the grounds. In such cases, NO refund will be issued.

**Ring Etiquette:** If you are not entered in a specific event, you are NOT permitted in the ring during the walk-through. Other than in secure, sealed food containers during FEO runs, food is not allowed in the ring. Volunteers are allowed water bottles.

Competitors will be notified of runtimes and order of go after May 20.

**Notice to Competitors:** All dogs must have an AAC ID number to compete. Please forward a copy of entire ID card with your entry confirmation email to [trials@capsagility.ca](mailto:trials@capsagility.ca), unless it's already on file.

**FEO Policy:** FEO runs are allowed. Please indicate them on the entry form. Use of non-audible toys and sealed food containers is allowed in the ring as specified in the AAC rules.

**BIS Policy:** Bitches in season (BIS) are allowed to be present on site and participate in AAC Trials at Canine Agility and Performance Sports (CAPS). At all times on site, except in the potty area, BIS are required to wear panties when they are outside of the ring. Panties may be removed while in the ring, and while running in the ring. There will be a designated parking and potty area for BIS. Per AAC rules, the BIS must use a start line mat – if not provided by the handler, one will be provided by CAPS. Per AAC rules, the BIS must run last in the running order of any class. If a competitor has a bitch that will be in season on the trial date, per AAC rules, the competitor must inform the Trials Secretary ([trials@capsagility.ca](mailto:trials@capsagility.ca)) as soon as they know their bitch is, or will be, in season, preferably prior to the Trial date, but worst case on the Trial date.

Per AAC rules, the Trials Secretary must inform all other competitors that there will be a BIS at the trial as soon as they are notified.

**Refund/Credit Policy:** There shall be no refunds or credits for acts of God, inclement weather, missed runs, if a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal, or in the event the dog is absent without prior notification on the day of the trial.

Refund of entry fees (an administrative fee of \$2.50 may be imposed), will be issued for withdrawals as follows:

- (1) for any reason prior to the Trial Closing Date;
- (2) a bitch which has come into season (BIS) should the handler decide not to run her;
- (3) a dog withdrawn because there will be a bitch in season at the trial;
- (4) an injured or sick dog (notification prior to trial date required, no proof required);
- (5) the dogs run by a handler who is injured or sick (notification prior to trial date required, no proof required);
- (6) after the Trial Closing Date for any other reasons will be considered for refund on a case-by-case basis.

**Awards:** Ribbons and rosettes are available as follows:

- Qualifying Rosettes or Flat Ribbons are self-serve for all event qualifiers;
- Flat Ribbons are self-serve for 1st through 4th place;
- There is a sign-up sheet for Title Rosettes for any dog achieving any AAC title at the trial. Title Rosettes will be publicly presented unless the handler requests otherwise;
- There is a Rosette for "Judges Choice"
