- 1- Applicant must be at least 14 years old by January 1, 2025.
- 2- Applicants must be in good standing with the California and National Junior Angus Associations.
- 3- Applicant must adhere by both the NJAA and the CJAA rules of conduct.
- 4- Scholarship will cover some or all of the travel costs and registration fees.
- 5- A personal interview may be requested at the annual CJAA Field Day. Applicants will be contacted in order to arrange a meeting.
- 6- **The deadline for applications is May 1, 2025.** The winners will be notified by May 15 to meet the Early Registration Deadline of June 1, 2025. Scholarship recipients will receive funds after they return from the conference so registration will need to be done independently.
- 7- Applications must be printed out in black ink.
- 8- Type font should be TIMES NEW ROMAN with font size of 10.
- 9- No additional information should be attached.
