

3 BASIC ESTATE PLANNING DOCUMENTS Your Should Have Now

these 3 documents, you will spare your loved ones a tremendous amount of unnecessary MONEY, TIME, WORK and CONFUSION.
LAST WILL & TESTAMENT
☐ Specifies how you want your estate to be distributed upon your death
□ Names the Guardian(s) of your minor child(ren) (or a Judge will have to decide for you)
□ Appoints someone as the <i>Executor</i> of your estate instead of the judge deciding (the person who will be in charge of distributing your assets according to your instructions in the Will)
HEALTHCARE DIRECTIVE (AKA LIVING WILL)
☐ Legally appoint someone as your Health Care Agent to make healthcare decisions for you when you cannot decide for yourself
☐ Formally state your preferences for the medical treatments you do or do not want to receive
POWER OF ATTORNEY
☐ Allows you to name one or more persons to handle your financial or business affairs for you just as you would if you were handling

- them yourself if you become sick or disabled, either temporarily or permanently
- ☐ Grants your Agent the power to handle your business or financial affairs upon you becoming incapacitated, which must be confirmed by 2 physicians.
- ☐ You maintain the control of your affairs until that time and can revoke it at anytime
