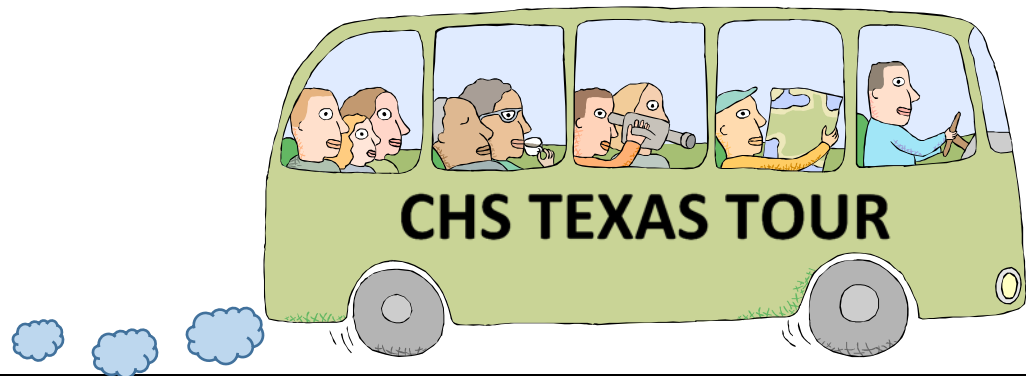


Want to be King or Queen for a day? Hop on the Bus!



On **September 15th @ 8:00 A.M.** the **CHS TEXAS TOUR BUS** will leave **St. Justin Martyr Church parking lot, 13350 Ashford Point Drive, Houston, 77082,** headed to **Bellville's Newman's Bakery** for a rest stop, then on to the Castle tour. Experience the old world charm of **Newman's Castle**, a one-of-a-kind custom creation hidden just outside of Bellville. The castle features a moat (watch out for gators!), a massive working 3,000 lb. drawbridge with an accompanying **portcullis**, a chapel, five round corner turrets, a courtyard, and a central keep with a dramatic view of the surrounding lands. A perimeter wall encompasses the castle, ensuring you are safe from incoming marauders. **After exploring all of the nooks and crannies of the castle, we will return to the Bakery for lunch,** then on to the San Felipe de Austin museum. **Bring a small cooler we will shop @ the Bellville Meat Market,** excellent sausage, jerky and huge tasty tamales **before heading out.**

In 1823, Stephen F. Austin established a headquarters in Mexican Texas @ **San Felipe de Austin**. Today, you can walk in the footsteps of early pioneers at what was the social, economic, and political center of American emigration to Texas before independence. **This is a brand new Texas Historical Site, just opened in April.**
