- Self-employed with own insurance
- Willing to undergo an enhanced DBS check & safeguard training
- Patient, kind but firm
- Looking for a rewarding opportunity

Essential/Desirable criteria

- Able to instruct pupils on correct swimming techniques and water safety
- Able to develop lesson plans tailored to individual or group needs
- Able to provide constructive feedback to students enabling them to improve swimming skills
- Ensure a safe and positive learning environment for all participants
- Monitor and enforce pool rules and regulations
- Previous experience in sports coaching or swim instruction is essential
- Ability to educate and communicate effectively with students of varying ages and skill levels
- Meet with the charity administrator three times a year to plan and organise the swimming group rotation and placements for each new term
- Preferably has some experience of working with children with additional needs although this is not essential
