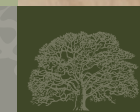

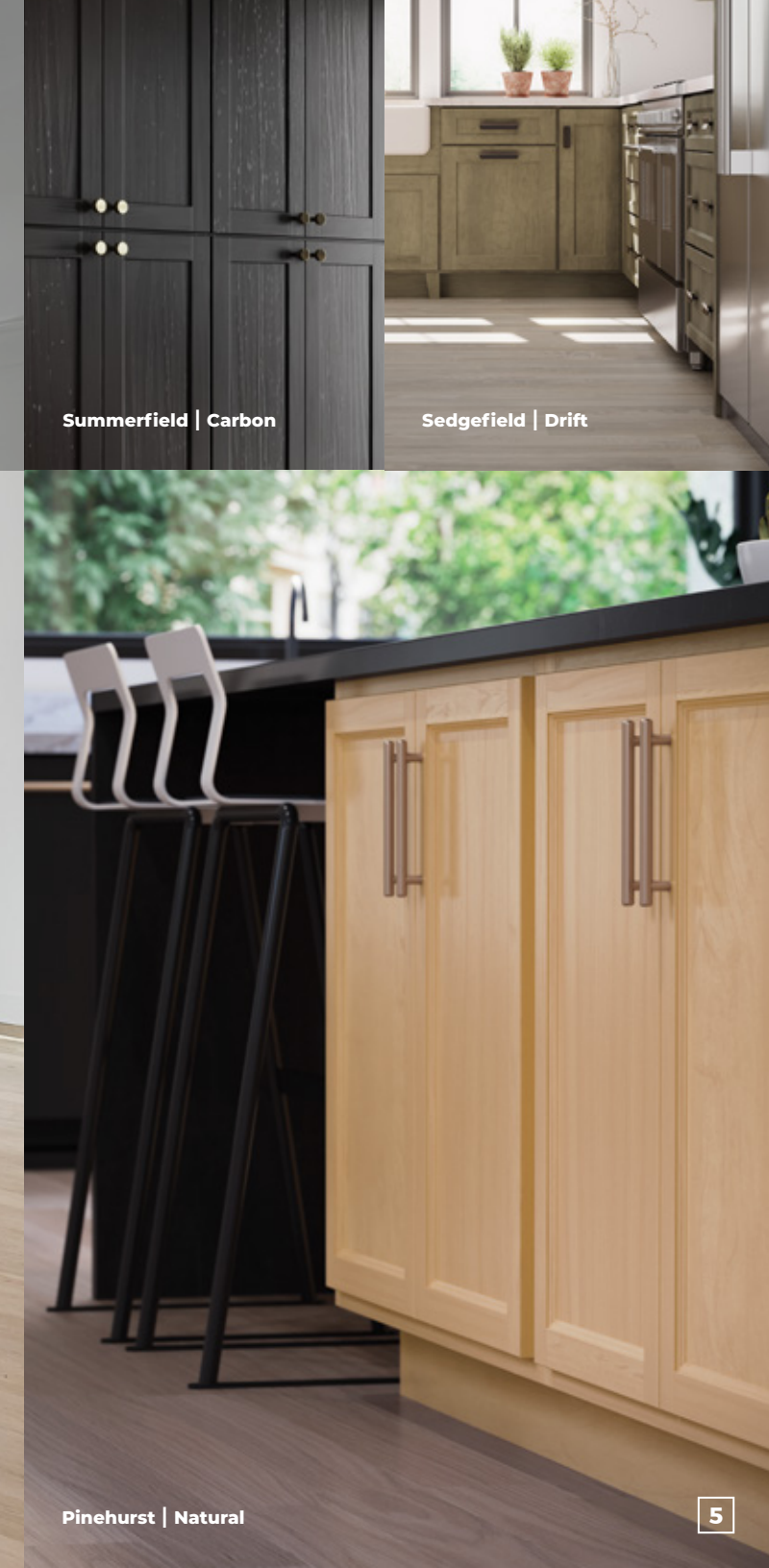
# NEUTRAL BY NATURE.

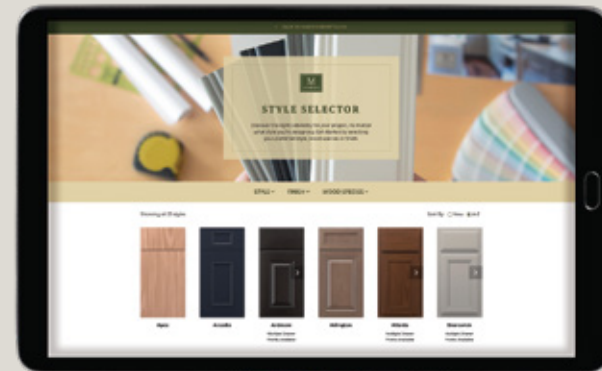
