2. **Swim Qualification Information:**
 - a. Each cadet must be wearing USNSCC approved swim attire:
 - i. Females must wear a black or blue 1 piece swimsuit (with or without shirt and shorts covering swimsuit, for comfort)
 - ii. Males must wear black or blue swim shorts that are loose and may not be considered speedo or race type style (with or without shirt, for comfort)
 - iii. Cadets will have access to NWU trousers for part of the swim qualification
 - iv. Cadets must move to and from pool with appropriate footwear as dictated by the facility being used
