THE HARM REDUCTION APPROACH

This guide was developed with harm reduction principles in mind, as detailed below. It emphasizes 1) the health and wellness of PWUD and 2) a respect for their autonomy, the right to decide what services they want to access and when.

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Naloxone, Safer use, and More

Harm reduction emphasizes minimizing harm and maximizing wellness, regardless whether a person wants to or is ready to modify their substance use.

Naloxone, fentanyl test strips, and tools for safer use, including education on how to keep a person safe.

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Naloxone (Narcan®)

Naloxone is the opioid overdose antidote, available intranasally as Narcan®.

Other Pharmacies

Maryland pharmacists are permitted to dispense naloxone without a prescription. They are not required to do so and may or may not have naloxone in stock. You should call first to confirm availability. If you go to any pharmacy other than ShopRite, you will be expected to self-pay or bill to your insurance.

Fentanyl test strips

Fentanyl test strips detect the presence of illicit fentanyl in street drugs. Detection of fentanyl prevents overdose death.

Detoxification and Withdrawal Management

Individuals who wish to stop or significantly reduce their substance use often require medical assistance to do so safely.

Rapid detoxification from alcohol is extremely dangerous. Those experiencing alcohol withdrawal should call 9-1-1 and immediately seek emergency care.

For people who use opioids, periods of abstinence can mean higher risk for overdose if they begin to use again. For some people, medications that minimize withdrawal symptoms and cravings help to enter and sustain recovery and reduce risk of overdose. 
