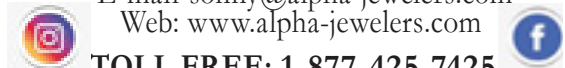

**REFLECTION**

**Understanding the Sriptures, Spreading it, and telling the Truth!**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The disciples of Jesus have been reading the Law of Moses, the Prophets, and the Psalms, but they never understood that what they were reading was going to be fulfilled in Jesus. It is after the resurrection that Jesus had to open their minds to understand what was written about Him in the scriptures. Without Jesus' help they could not understand the scriptures. We also do read the Bible today, and very often with pride because we are intellectuals. Because we have been to school, because we have degrees and diplomas, we presume that we are able to understand the scriptures, whereas it is not true! When we were starting our theological studies, I remember that one of our teachers used to tell us that "unlike in Philosophy where we primarily use our minds or reason, here in theology, you need to kneel down if you want to understand God and His word." In other words, you can understand God and His word or the scriptures only if you refer to God Himself to enlighten you. That is why we have to pray so that Jesus should also open our minds to understand the scriptures, no matter the number of degrees we have.

Once we understand scriptures, we know God, and His commandments. In the Biblical sense, knowledge of God and of His word is not just an intellectual knowledge; it is more than that. It means as St. John puts it in his first letter, "to keep his commandments," to keep His word, that is, to put it into practice. That is why St. John says that "those who say, "I know Him", but do not keep His commandments are liars, and the truth is not in them". In fact, when we know the word of God, it operates a change in us, it sets us on a mission. When Jesus opened the minds of His disciples to understand the scriptures, He said to them:

**Reflection** (continued)

"Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in His name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are the witness of these things." We can therefore understand the attitude of Peter in the Acts of the Apostles. He who denied Jesus, who was coward, is the one who now proclaims aloud to the people: "and the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, God of Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified his servant Jesus whom you handed over and denied in Pilate's presence when he had decided to release him. You denied the Holy and Righteous One and asked the murderer to be released to you. The author of life you put to death, but God raised him from the dead; of this we are witnesses. (Acts 3: 13-15) We see that Peter is no more the coward and fearful of old; he is courageous to affirm his relationship with Jesus, to preach the truth of the word of God, to challenge the people in their behavior and to affirm that he is a witness of Jesus' resurrection. He wants his hearers to be converted. He is totally a converted person, no longer the one who denied Jesus. When we know God and His word, that is how we are also to become converted, to become new people who preach the word of God and who are witnesses to the gospel, and who help others to be converted. That is our mission; not an easy mission because people would not always like us to tell them the truth of the gospel about God and about them, and also because we do not always have the courage to tell the truth to people.

Let us ask God to grant us the courage to carry out our mission of spreading his word to all people without fear, and the grace of conversion like Peter, in order to remain faithful to Jesus all the days of our lives.

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the parish office 9-12 months prior to the celebration and talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. Please visit our website www.cathedralvi.org or call us at 340-774-0201. The Sacrament of Marriage is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please contact the parish priest if you would like a different time for your wedding. (Note that Saturday mornings are reserved for cleaning and decorating the cathedral.)

**REFLEXIÓN**

¡Entender las Escrituras, difundirlas, y decir la Verdad!

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Los discípulos de Jesús han estado leyendo la Ley de Moisés, los Profetas y los Salmos, pero nunca entendieron que lo que leían se iba a cumplir en Jesús. Es después de la resurrección que Jesús tuvo que abrirles la mente para comprender en las Escrituras lo que estaba escrito sobre Él. Sin la ayuda de Jesús no podrían entender las Escrituras. También leemos la Biblia hoy, y muy a menudo con orgullo porque somos intelectuales. Debido a que hemos asistido a la escuela, a que tenemos títulos y diplomas, suponemos que somos capaces de entender las Escrituras, ¡pero no es cierto! Cuando empezábamos nuestros estudios teológicos, recuerdo que uno de nuestros profesores solía decirnos que “a diferencia de la Filosofía, donde usamos principalmente la mente o la razón, aquí en teología, debes arrodillarte si quieres entender a Dios y Su palabra.” En otras palabras, puedes entender a Dios y Su palabra o las Escrituras sólo si recurres a Dios mismo para que te ilumine. Por eso tenemos que orar para que Jesús también abra nuestra mente para entender las Escrituras, sin importar la cantidad de grados que tengamos.

Una vez que entendemos las Escrituras, conocemos a Dios, conocemos Sus mandamientos. En el sentido bíblico, el conocimiento de Dios y de su palabra no es sólo un conocimiento intelectual; Es más que eso. Significa, como dice San Juan en su primera carta, “guardar sus mandamientos”, guardar su palabra, es decir, ponerla en práctica. Por eso dice San Juan que “los que dicen: Yo le conozco, pero no guardan sus mandamientos, son mentirosos y no hay verdad en ellos”. De hecho, cuando conocemos la palabra de Dios, ella opera un cambio en nosotros, nos pone en una misión. Cuando Jesús abrió la mente de sus discípulos para comprender las Escrituras, les dijo: “Así está escrito que el Cristo sufriría y resucitaría de entre los muertos al tercer día y que se predicaría el arrepentimiento para el perdón de los pecados. en su nombre a todas las naciones, comenzando desde Jerusalén. Tú eres testigo de estas cosas”. Por tanto, podemos comprender la actitud de Pedro en los Hechos de los Apóstoles. El que negó a Jesús, que fue cobarde, es el que ahora proclama en voz alta al pueblo: “al Dios de Abraham, el Dios de Isaac, el Dios de Jacob, el Dios de nuestros padres, ha glorificado a su siervo Jesús, a quien entregó.
