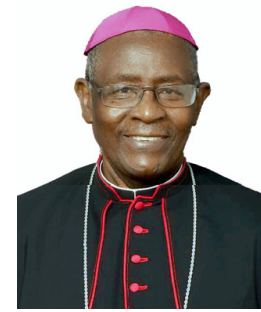

REFLECTION

“The Good Shepherd”

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We celebrate today, the 4th Sunday of Easter which is also called “Sunday of the Good Shepherd”. Today in the Gospel, Jesus presents himself as the Good Shepherd and says what characterizes a good shepherd: – he lays down his life for his sheep, that is, he is capable of sacrificing himself for the sheep to the point of giving his life for the sheep, unlike a hired man who will run away and abandon the sheep in the face of difficulties; he does not work for pay but out of love, unlike a hired man. –he knows his own and his own know him. It means that he pays attention to all in order to be able to know them and for them to know him.– he takes care of the other sheep that do not belong to this fold. It means he goes out of his way to look for the ones that are elsewhere or which go astray. He neglects no one, each of them is important in his sight. That is why he looks after each of them.

This description of the good shepherd with his qualities reflect what those who are shepherds in the church and in society should be. In fact, we are all supposed to be good shepherd from the Pope to the last Christian. We are all supposed to be shepherding a large, medium or a small group wherever we are. The Pope has to shepherd the whole universal church. That is why he generally travels around the world to encourage Christians in their faith. The Bishops have the responsibility of shepherding their faithful in their diocese; but with the Pope, they have not only the responsibility of all the church, of all the faithful in the church or in their respective dioceses, but also of those that are not in their diocese. That is why they should pray for all the churches all over the world and feel for those in trouble in other parts of the world. They are not only to pray for them, but also to stand in solidarity with them. This solidarity is not just spiritual, but also material and pastoral.

Reflection (continued)

That is why sometimes we are asked to make some special collection to help other Christians in need in other parts of the world. That is also why the Pope encourages Bishops who have more vocations (more priests and religious) to help those dioceses which have less Priests and religious, by sending personnel to them as missionaries. The Pope and the Bishops in the world do not have to concentrate only on the Catholic faithful who are regularly in the church, but also to have special attention to Christians who have left the church. That is why there is a relation between the Catholic Church and other churches (oecumenism), and even with the non-Christian religions since the command of Christ was: “Go and announce the good news to the whole world” (Mt: 28: 19) The priests are to assist the Bishop and the Pope in all these missions as they cannot cover all the world nor all their dioceses alone. They are all to pay attention to everyone with the help of all the faithful as well, the deacons, lectors, the mass servants, the choirs, the catholic charity, and each Christian. We are all to watch over the small group entrusted to our care at whatever level.

Since the family is the domestic church, we are also called to be good shepherds in the family, knowing everyone by name and looking after them, sacrificing ourselves for them. But unfortunately, we notice that there are some parents who do not even know all their children well, who do not sacrifice themselves for them, and for their education, just as there are some children who do not know their parents as such, to honor them in order to be blessed and to have long life on earth. For true, we are all called to be good shepherds wherever God calls us to serve Him. It can be in the family, in our various associations, in the church, in our workplaces, ...

Let us ask God to grant us the grace to be good shepherds where He has placed us so that we too may be able to sacrifice ourselves for those who depend on us in one way or another and wherever. In that way, we will also deserve to share Christ’s glory forever.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the parish office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the parish office 9-12 months prior to the celebration and talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. Please visit our website www.cathedralvi.org or call us at 340-774-0201. The Sacrament of Marriage is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please contact the parish priest if you would like a different time for your wedding. (Note that Saturday mornings are reserved for cleaning and decorating the cathedral.)

VISITING AND ANNOINTING THE SICK:

If anyone in your family is sick or shut-in, please inform the parish office so that we can pray for them and arrange to visit them. Please note that the hospital does not notify us when Catholics are in the hospital. Please call the parish office to inform us of a Catholic in the hospital who needs to have a priest visit. Thank you!

FUNERAL MASSES:

Funeral Masses at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral are held on the designated day at 9:30AM. Please make arrangements with the Church office before the funeral home to assure availability of the date requested. The Funeral Program should read "Christian Burial" on the cover. If you would like a different time, please contact the parish priest. Viewings will not take place inside the cathedral. Funerals generally are not held on weekends (Saturday or Sunday). REFLEXIÓN

“El buen Pastor”

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Celebramos hoy el IV Domingo de Pascua, también llamado “Domingo del Buen Pastor”. Hoy en el Evangelio, Jesús se presenta como el Buen Pastor y dice lo que caracteriza a un buen pastor: – da su vida por sus ovejas, es decir es capaz de sacrificarse por las ovejas hasta dar su vida por las ovejas, a diferencia de un asalariado que huye y abandona las ovejas ante las dificultades, él no trabaja por remuneración sino por amor, a diferencia de un asalariado. –él conoce a los suyos y los suyos lo conocen a él. Quiere decir que presta atención a todas para poder conocerlas y que ellas le conozcan a él.– cuida de las otras ovejas que no pertenecen a este redil. Significa que se esfuerza por buscar los que están en otra parte o los que se han extraviado. No descuida a nadie, cada uno de ellos es importante ante sus ojos. Por eso cuida de cada uno de ellos.

Esta descripción del buen pastor con sus cualidades refleja lo que deben ser quienes son pastores en la iglesia y en la sociedad. De hecho, se supone que todos debemos ser buenos pastores desde el Papa hasta el último cristiano. Se supone que todos debemos pastorear a un grupo grande, mediano o pequeño dondequiera que estemos. El Papa tiene que pastorear a toda la Iglesia universal. Por eso generalmente viaja por todo el mundo para animar a los cristianos en su fe. Los Obispos tienen la responsabilidad de pastorear a sus fieles en su diócesis; pero con el Papa no sólo tienen la responsabilidad de toda la Iglesia, de todos los fieles en la Iglesia o en sus respectivas diócesis, sino también de los que no están en la diócesis. Por eso deberían orar por todas las iglesias del mundo y sentir compasión por aquellos que tienen problemas en otras partes del mundo. No sólo deben orar por ellos, sino también vivir una cierta solidaridad con ellos. Esta solidaridad no es sólo espiritual, sino también material y pastoral. Por eso a veces se nos pide hacer alguna colecta especial para ayudar a otros cristianos necesitados en otras partes del mundo. Por eso también el Papa anima a los obispos que tienen más vocaciones (más sacerdotes y religiosos) a ayudar a aquellas diócesis que tienen menos sacerdotes y religiosos, enviándoles personal como misioneros. El Papa y los obispos del mundo no deben concentrarse sólo en los fieles católicos que asisten regularmente a la iglesia, sino también prestar especial atención a los cristianos que han abandonado la iglesia. Por eso hay una relación entre la Iglesia católica y otras iglesias (ecumenismo), e incluso con las no cristianas. Las religiones desde el mandato de Cristo fue: “Id y anunciad la buena nueva al mundo entero” (Mt: 28)
