

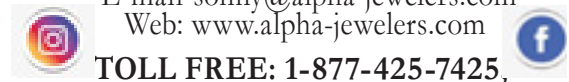

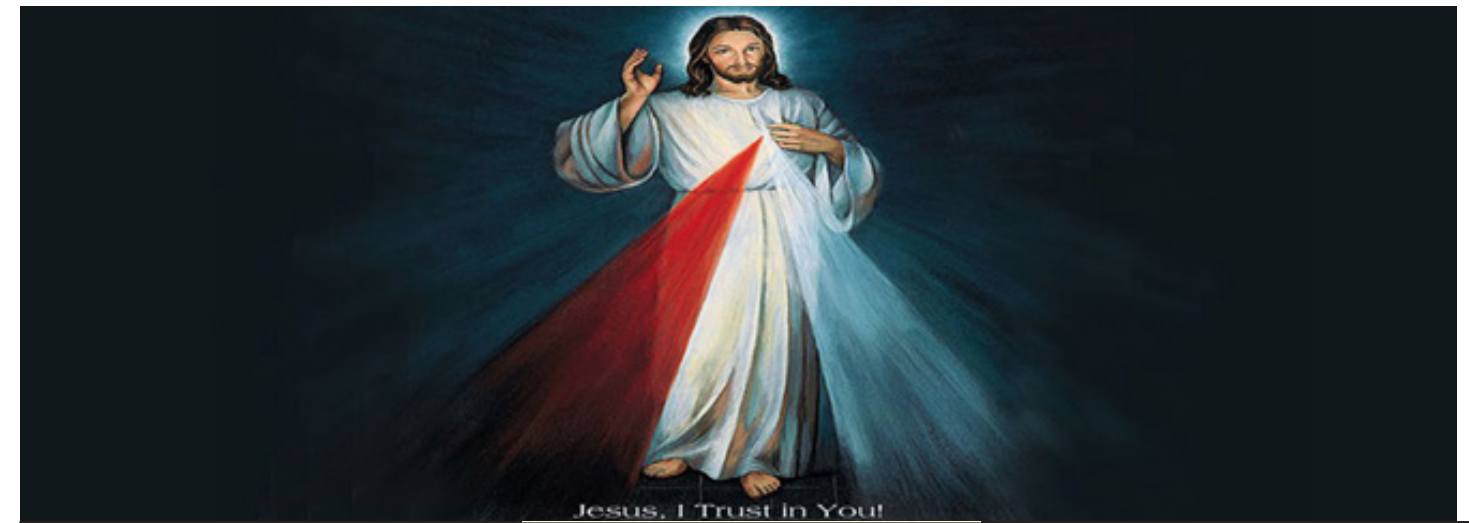

REFLECTION

Be Merciful Like Our God!

Dear Brothers & Sisters,

We celebrate today in communion with the whole church the second Sunday of Easter which is also called Sunday of Divine Mercy. St. Augustine used to define mercy as the “heartfelt sympathy for another’s distress, impelling us to succor him if we can”. God is very merciful to us, that is why we are still alive and active, for if He were to consider our sins, our hatred, our jealousy, our betrayal, He would not come to our help when we are in distress or in difficult situations. That is why in order to really be in his image and likeness, we also have to be merciful people, that is, people who show mercy to others by being sensitive to their needs and difficulties. The first Christian community whose story we hear the Acts of the Apostles, understood this very well. That is why they were “of one heart and mind” and “had everything in common”, using what they had to come to the help of those in need. They were not selfish, neither egoistic, nor egocentric like many of us in the world today. That was their way of living their faith in practice. That is something we too have to learn from them because in the world today, many people think, say, or do things only in the first person or for the first person: “I, Me”. We need to think, say, and do things for the good of others or of all as well. That is what is pleasing to God, to our Lord Jesus who was a person totally for others and for God. Let us imitate Him!

We see that after the resurrection, Jesus thinks of his disciples and appears to them to console them, encourage them, reassure them. He knows their troubles of the moment: It is interesting to see how he addresses their need of the moment: “Peace be with you”, He says it three times in the gospel of today, in the same meeting with his disciples who were in with the doors locked, for fear of the Jews.

Reflection(continued)

God also gives us the grace to see the needs of our people, of our friends, of those with whom we are; but are we also merciful to them by being sensitive to their needs and granting them spontaneously what they need? Or what will contribute to their peace?

In their trouble, the disciples needed peace. Jesus was sensitive to that. In our world today, people still need peace more than ever before: Many people are troubled everywhere in the world and want some peace. The cause of their trouble might be we, or the family, their friends, their colleagues, their children, their wife or husband, their job, their relationship with others, their studies, their teachers, their clients, their nurse, their patient, ... Let us see what we can do at our own level to make them have peace. That would be our own concrete way of living the faith in imitation of Christ. Unfortunately, our faith is sometimes doubtful like that of Thomas today. He refuses to believe in the resurrection of Jesus, unless he sees the mark of the nails in his hands, puts his fingers into the nail marks and out his hand in his side. But what is interesting is that when next time the risen Christ will appear to the disciples in his presence, Thomas will affirm his faith in Jesus in these words: “My Lord and my God.”

When Thomas saw the signs that Jesus showed him, he believed and changed to become a more active disciple. Jesus continues to show us the signs of his presence in the world and in our lives, but then how do we react? Do we also acknowledge Him as the author of all the good we see or have? Do we consequently adore him? Very often, we take many things for granted; we forget that they are signs of God’s mercy to us. Let us tell Him we are sorry and beg Him to grant us the grace we need so as to acknowledge Him to be the Lord and to give Him the praise that is due! May He also grant us the grace to be merciful in turn towards others. Amen!

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are generally held on the last Sunday of the month. Requests for a different date and time will be honored to the extent possible. Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the parish office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the parish office 9-12 months prior to the celebration and talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. Please visit our website www.cathedralvi.org or call us at 340-774-0201. The Sacrament of Marriage is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please contact the parish priest if you would like a different time for your wedding. (Note that Saturday mornings are reserved for cleaning and decorating the cathedral.)

VISITING AND ANNOINTING THE SICK:

If anyone in your family is sick or shut-in, please inform the parish office so that we can pray for them and arrange to visit them. Please note that the hospital does not notify us when Catholics are in the hospital. Please call the parish office to inform us of a Catholic in the hospital who needs to have a priest visit. Thank you!

FUNERAL MASSES:

Funeral Masses at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral are held on the designated day at 9:30AM. Please make arrangements with the Church office before the funeral home to assure availability of the date requested. The Funeral Program should read "Christian Burial" on the cover. If you would like a different time, please contact the parish priest. Viewings will not take place inside the cathedral. Funerals generally are not held on weekends (Saturday or Sunday). Thank you for your cooperation.

REFLEXIÓN

¡Sé misericordioso como nuestro Dios!

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Celebramos hoy en comunión con toda la iglesia el segundo domingo de Pascua que también se llama Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. San Agustín solía definir la misericordia como la “sentida simpatía por la angustia del otro, impulsándonos a socorrerlo si podemos”. Dios es muy misericordioso con nosotros, por eso seguimos vivos y activos, porque si El considerara nuestros pecados, nuestro odio, nuestros celos, nuestra traición, no vendría en nuestro auxilio cuando estemos en angustia o en dificultades. situaciones. Por eso, para ser realmente a su imagen y semejanza, tenemos que ser también personas misericordiosas, es decir, personas que muestran misericordia hacia los demás siendo sensibles a sus necesidades y dificultades. La primera comunidad cristiana cuya historia escuchamos en los Hechos de los Apóstoles lo entendió muy bien. Por eso eran “de un solo corazón y de mente” y “tenían todo en común”, utilizando lo que tenían para ayudar a los necesitados. No eran egoístas, ni egoístas, ni egocéntricos como muchos de nosotros en el mundo de hoy. Esa era su manera de vivir su fe en la práctica. Eso es algo que nosotros también tenemos que aprender de ellos porque en el mundo de hoy mucha gente piensa, dice o hace las cosas sólo en primera persona o para la primera persona: “Yo, Yo”. Necesitamos pensar, decir y hacer las cosas por el bien de los demás o también de todos. Eso es lo que agrada a Dios, a nuestro Señor Jesús que fue persona totalmente para los demás y para Dios. ¡Imitémoslo!

Vemos que después de la resurrección, Jesús piensa en sus discípulos y se les aparece para consolarlos, animarlos, tranquilizarlos. Él conoce sus problemas del momento: Es interesante ver cómo aborda su necesidad del momento: “La paz esté con vosotros”, lo dice tres veces en el evangelio de hoy, en el mismo encuentro con sus discípulos que estaban en con las puertas cerradas, por miedo a los judíos. Dios también nos da la gracia de ver las necesidades de nuestro pueblo, de nuestros amigos, de aquellos con quienes estamos; pero ¿somos también misericordiosos con ellos siendo sensibles a sus necesidades y concediéndoles espontáneamente lo que necesitan? ¿O qué contribuirá a su paz?

REFLEXIÓN continuada

En medio de sus problemas, los discípulos necesitaban paz. Jesús fue sensible a eso. En nuestro mundo actual, la gente todavía necesita la paz más que nunca: muchas personas tienen problemas en todas partes del mundo y quieren algo de paz. La causa de su problema podemos ser nosotros, o la familia, sus amigos, sus colegas, sus hijos, su esposa o esposo, su trabajo, su relación con los demás, sus estudios, sus maestros, sus clientes, su enfermera, su paciente, ... Veamos qué podemos hacer a nuestro nivel para que tengan paz. Esa sería nuestra manera concreta de vivir la fe a imitación de Cristo. Desafortunadamente, nuestra fe es a veces dudosa como la de Tomás hoy. Se niega a creer en la resurrección de Jesús, a menos que vea la marca de los clavos en sus manos, meta los dedos en las marcas de los clavos y saque la mano en el costado. Pero lo interesante es que la próxima vez que Cristo resucitado se aparezca a los discípulos en su presencia, Tomás afirmará su fe en Jesús con estas palabras: “Señor mío y Dios mío”.

Cuando Tomás vio las señales que Jesús le mostraba, creyó y cambió para convertirse en un discípulo más activo. Jesús continúa mostrándonos los signos de su presencia en el mundo y en nuestras vidas, pero entonces ¿cómo reaccionamos? ¿Lo reconocemos también como el autor de todo el bien que vemos o tenemos? ¿Lo adoramos en consecuencia? Muy a menudo damos por sentado muchas cosas; olvidamos que son signos de la misericordia de Dios para con nosotros. ¡Digámosle que lo sentimos y roguémosle que nos conceda la gracia que necesitamos para reconocerlo como el Señor y darle la alabanza debida! Que El también nos conceda la gracia de ser también misericordiosos con los demás. ¡Amén!
