REFLECTION

May God grant us the sense of sacrifice for Him and for our brothers and sisters

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ.

In the first reading the experience that Abraham has lived sheds some light on the experiences we sometimes go through in our own spiritual journey with God. In fact Abraham had not yet known much about God in the sense that he had not yet experienced God in his life directly as God was manifesting Himself to him in a sensible manner. God had promised him a son in his old age and actually fulfilled his promise. This only child of his gives him joy all the more as he will be his successor to whom he will leave the heritage. But behold, this only child, the most precious gift that God gave him is the one that God is asking as sacrifice. This demand is too much and weighs down on Abraham. It would be interesting to see what could be his psychological state at that time. He was completely downcast. This was a test of faith. I do not know how we would have reacted in the place of Abraham. May be many of us would have refused to answer God's request.

It is in that same way that God puts us to the test very often in our lives. He gives us many things, some of which are precious. He also asks us from time to time to make a bit of sacrifice for Him out of what He has given us, but we do refuse. Let us see the value of what we offer Him in Church as our own sacrifice during offertory. Is it worthwhile compared to what God has given us?

Sometimes God puts in our way some people who need our help in kind or in cash, or even in time as well. But are we sensitive to their needs? We are not usually sensitive to the needs of the poorer ones nor of those brothers and sisters who need our help. In the gospel of Matthew, let us not forget that Jesus reminds us that in so far as you did good to anyone hungry, thirsty, naked, sick, in prison, a stranger, you did it to Him, and because of that you will not lose anything; on the contrary, you will be rewarded beyond comparison. It is a matter of faith. Do we believe it? I don't think so!

Reflection(continued)

Even the apostles did not believe that the reward that awaits them who make sacrifices for God will be great and beyond comparison on earth. That is why Jesus had to take Peter, James, and John up a high mountain in order to be transfigured before them and make them have a foretaste of what they will have as reward after the sacrifices and sufferings of this world in His name. The experience of the transfiguration was so marvelous, sublime and unique that Peter had to say: "Rabbi, it is good that we are here! Let us make three tents: one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." It was so good being there, that they no longer wanted to come down the mountain to live their ordinary life. When they came down, they became different. They became faithful followers of Jesus. What about us? You cannot see God or experience God's love and remain the same; but we do often remain the same, refusing to change, refusing to show love in turn to others whereas we have been beneficiaries of God's love and bounty. When we do experience God's love in our lives, we must be able to remain united to Him and charitable as well towards our brothers and sisters. That is what will show our faith in God.

During our mass, let us tell God that we are sorry for the many times that we have not readily accepted to make some sacrifices for Him, or in His name, for our brothers and sisters. May He grant us the sense of sacrifice for Him and for others! Amen!

Heavenly Father, during this Lenten season, give me a new and expanded vision for my life. Help me to live full of faith. Teach me to find hope in the face of adversity.



SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are generally held on the last Sunday of the month. Requests for a different date and time will be honored to the extent possible. Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the parish office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the parish office 9-12 months prior to the celebration and talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. Please visit our website www.cathedralvi.org or call us at 340-774-0201. The Sacrament of Marriage is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please contact the parish priest if you would like a different time for your wedding. (Note that Saturday mornings are reserved for cleaning and decorating the cathedral.)

VISITING AND ANNOINTING THE SICK:

If anyone in your family is sick or shut-in, please inform the parish office so that we can pray for them and arrange to visit them. Please note that the hospital does not notify us when Catholics are in the hospital. Please call the parish office to inform us of a Catholic in the hospital who needs to have a priest visit. Thank you!

FUNERAL MASSES:

Funeral Masses at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral are held on the designated day at 9:30AM. Please make arrangements with the Church office before the funeral home to assure availability of the date requested. The Funeral Program should read "Christian Burial" on the cover. If you would like a different time, please contact the parish priest. Viewings will not take place inside the cathedral. Funerals generally are not held on weekends (Saturday or Sunday). Thank you for your cooperation.

REFLEXÍON por: Padre Joseph Nguele TOKO

Que Dios nos conceda el sentido de sacrificio por Él y por nuestros hermanos y hermanas.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En la primera lectura, la experiencia que vivió Abraham arroja algo de luz sobre las experiencias que a veces pasamos en nuestro propio camino espiritual con Dios. De hecho, Abraham todavía no había sabido mucho acerca de Dios en el sentido de que todavía no había experimentado a Dios en su vida directamente mientras Dios se manifestaba a él de una manera sensible. Dios le había prometido un hijo en su vejez y efectivamente cumplió su promesa. Este hijo único le da aún más alegría porque será su sucesor a quien dejará la herencia. Pero he aquí a este hijo único, el don más precioso que Dios le dio es el que Dios le pide como sacrificio. Esta exigencia es demasiada y pesa sobre Abraham Sería interesante ver cuál podría ser su estado psicológico en ese momento. Estaba completamente abatido. Esta fue una prueba de fe. No sé cómo hubiéramos reaccionado nosotros en el lugar de Abraham. Quizás muchos de nosotros nos hubiéramos negado a responder a la petición de Dios.

Es de esa misma manera que Dios nos pone a prueba muy a menudo en nuestra vida. Nos da muchas cosas, algunas de las cuales son preciosas. También nos pide de vez en cuando que hagamos un poco de sacrificio por Él de lo que nos ha dado, pero nosotros nos negamos. Veamos el valor de lo que le ofrecemos en la Iglesia como nuestro propio sacrificio durante el ofertorio ¿Vale la pena comparado con lo que Dios nos ha dado?

A veces Dios pone en nuestro camino algunas personas que necesitan nuestra ayuda en especie o en efectivo, o incluso en tiempo también. ¿Pero somos sensibles a sus necesidades? Generalmente no somos sensibles a las necesidades de los más pobres ni de aquellos hermanos y hermanas que necesitan nuestra ayuda En el evangelio de Mateo, no olvidemos que Jesús nos recuerda que en cuanto hicisteis el bien a alguien hambriento, sediento, desnudo, enfermo, en la cárcel, a un extraño,...a Él se lo hicisteis, y porque de eso no perderéis nada; al contrario, serás recompensado sin comparación. Es una cuestión de fe. ¿Lo creemos? ¡No me parece!

Ni siquiera los apóstoles creían que la recompensa que les espera a quienes hacen sacrificios por Dios sería grande e incomparable en la tierra. Por eso Jesús tuvo que llevar a Pedro, Santiago y Juan a un monte alto para transfigurarse delante de ellos y hacerles tener un anticipo de lo que tendrán como recompensa después de los sacrificios y sufrimientos de este mundo en Su nombre. La experiencia de la transfiguración fue tan maravillosa, sublime y única que Pedro tuvo que decir:
