**MEDITATION**

**Jesus is sending us all on mission.**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The liturgy of today makes us see how Jesus is sending the twelve on mission. He sends them two by two; no one is sent alone. He gives them some instructions on how to go and what to do. With them we too are sent on mission to preach repentance to people. But we are not sent alone, we are to work with others in the Church. Unfortunately, many Christians do not accept others and want to work alone in the Church. We need to have the sense of collaboration and of cooperation as we work for God in the Church. We should also learn to respect the instructions that are given to us by our superiors.

Jesus did not simply send the apostles on mission like that. He gave them the means for their mission. He gave them power, authority over unclean spirits. Very often we do ask people to do things for us, we do send them on mission, but we do not always think of the means we are to give them so that the mission is carried out perfectly. Surprisingly we are sometimes the first to complain that things were not well done whereas we are the ones who did not do things right. We should learn to give people the means for their mission and evaluate them on that account.

**Meditation** (continued)

What is also surprising is the fact that Jesus sends his apostles to strange places and ask them to take nothing for the road, but a walking stick – no food, no sack, no money, no second tunic, ... - He wants them to concentrate on their mission, and God will take care of the rest, of their needs. Jesus is thus teaching them the notion of Providence (God who provides for our needs). This shows that we need to have faith in God in order to rely on Him totally. Brothers and sisters, we should know that when we give ourselves to work for God, He really takes care of us. But it is difficult for people to really believe in The Providence of God when we do work for Him. That is why we do say at times that “prevention is better than cure”. For true, God does not abandon his people who trust and work for Him. I am sure that we might have had that experience before but we did not pay attention to God’s action in our lives. Each of us has eventually found himself in a situation where he had to offer the last money, he had to someone in need. That same day or the following day someone gave us more money or we made a good business that gave us more money. It is divine providence, the action of God who does not allow us to compete with Him in generosity. Let us therefore take the habit of doing things in God’s name, or sacrificing ourselves for our brothers and sisters in need in God’s name, knowing that He who sees what we are doing in secret will reward us.

Finally, Jesus wants his disciples to be stable where they are welcomed: ” Whenever you enter a house, stay there until you leave.” When we see the way some people change houses, we begin to wonder whether they are serious people. What is important is that we be welcomed and do have peace. It is that peace that we are also to bring to the people of the house. Let us therefore not be like those whose coming or presence brings but trouble in the place. God wants us to be stable where we find ourselves and to assume our ministry there. Let us ask for that grace during the mass of today.

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:**

The Sacrament of Marriage is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please contact the parish priest if you would like a different time for your wedding. If anyone in your family is sick or shut-in, please inform the parish office so that we can pray for them and arrange to visit them. Funeral Masses at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral are held on the designated day at 9:30AM. **Jesús nos está enviando a todos en misión**

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

La liturgia de hoy nos hace ver cómo Jesús envía a los doce en misión. Los envía de dos en dos; nadie es enviado solo. Les da algunas instrucciones sobre cómo ir y qué hacer. Con ellos también nosotros somos enviados en misión a predicar el arrepentimiento a la gente. Pero no somos enviados solos, debemos trabajar con otros en la Iglesia. Lamentablemente, muchos cristianos no aceptan a los demás y quieren trabajar solos en la Iglesia. Necesitamos tener un sentido de colaboración y cooperación mientras trabajamos para Dios en la Iglesia. También debemos aprender a respetar las instrucciones que nos dan nuestros superiores.

Jesús no envió simplemente al apóstol a una misión así. Les dio los medios para su misión. Les dio poder, autoridad sobre los espíritus inmundos. Muy a menudo pedimos a la gente que haga cosas por nosotros, los enviamos a la misión, pero no siempre pensamos en los medios que debemos darles para que la misión se lleve a cabo perfectamente. Sorprendentemente, a veces somos los primeros en quejarnos de que las cosas no se hicieron bien, siendo nosotros los que no las hicimos bien. Deberíamos aprender a dar a las personas los medios para su misión y evaluarlas en ese sentido. Lo que también sorprende es que Jesús envía a sus apóstoles a lugares extraños y les pide que no lleven nada para el camino, excepto un bastón: ni comida, ni saco, ni dinero, ni una segunda túnica... - Él quiere que se concentren en su misión, y Dios se encargará del resto, de sus necesidades. Jesús les está enseñando así la noción de Providencia (Dios que provee para nuestras necesidades). Esto muestra que necesitamos tener fe en Dios para poder confiar totalmente en Él. Hermanos y hermanas, debemos saber que cuando nos entregamos a trabajar para Dios, Él realmente cuida de nosotros. Pero es difícil para las personas creer realmente en la Providencia de Dios cuando trabajamos para Él. Por eso decimos a veces que “más vale prevenir que curar.”

En verdad, Dios no abandona a su pueblo que confía y trabaja para Él. Estoy seguro de que podríamos haber tenido esa experiencia antes pero no prestamos atención a la acción de Dios en nuestras vidas. Al final, cada uno de nosotros se ha encontrado en una situación en la que ha tenido que ofrecer el último dinero que tenía a alguien que lo necesitaba. Ese mismo día o al día siguiente alguien nos dio más dinero o hicimos un buen negocio que nos dio más dinero. Es la divina providencia, la acción de Dios que no nos permite competir con Él en generosidad. Tomemos, pues, el hábito de hacer cosas en nombre de Dios, o de sacrificarnos por nuestros hermanos necesitados en nombre de Dios, sabiendo que aquel que ve lo que hacemos en secreto nos recompensará.

Finalmente, Jesús quiere que sus discípulos estén estables donde sean acogidos: “Donde entréis en una casa, permaneced allí hasta que salgáis”. Cuando vemos la forma en que algunas personas cambian de casa, empezamos a preguntarnos si son personas serias. Lo importante es que seamos bienvenidos y tengamos paz. Es esa paz la que también debemos llevar a la gente de la casa. Por tanto, no seamos como los que vienen, o la presencia sólo trae problemas en el lugar. Dios quiere que estemos estables donde nos encontramos y que asumamos allí nuestro ministerio. Pidamos esa gracia durante la misa de hoy.
