

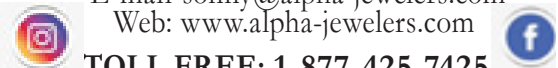

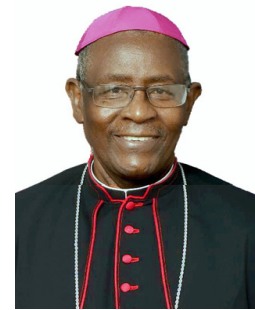

MEDITATION

Turn To Jesus In Time Of Trouble

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Liturgy of today helps us to see how God dominates every situation, even the ones that could be unthinkable. The disciples experience this in the gospel passage of today. (Mark 4: 35-41)

In fact, Jesus is crossing the sea with His disciples in the boat. Suddenly a violent storm makes the sea so furious that the disciples begin to fear for their lives because the waves are breaking over the boat. This experience of the disciples with Jesus in the boat is similar to ours in life. For true, life on earth is like crossing the sea where you have moments of calm as well as moments of turbulence with violent waves which shake us, threaten us, make us fear for our lives sometimes. When those moments of difficulties come, we sometimes try to face them alone; we forget that Jesus is by our side, present and paying attention. Like the disciples in the gospel, we sometimes think that He is asleep and does not pay attention to us nor to what is happening. We say: God is not attentive to our problems or to our needs. Does He not see how things are falling apart in our lives?

When the disciples noticed that they were helpless and that they could no longer face the difficulty of the sea, they turned to Jesus, woke Him up and said: "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" They knew that only Jesus could save them at this point. When we find ourselves in difficult situations, to whom do we turn? Do we have enough faith to turn to Jesus for help? The lack of faith is what made the disciples fear.

Meditation (continued)

That is why Jesus asked them: "Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?" It is the same lack of faith that makes us fear very often. We do not trust God enough. That is why we find people going to some other churches that are not Catholic, or to some sects like the Rosicrucian Order, the freemasonry and others in search of salvation or easy solution to their problems.

In fact, by choosing to cross the sea with His disciples, Jesus wants to show them that He has power over the forces of nature that man dreads. By subduing them, Jesus reveals Himself as almighty and thus reassures His disciples that He has powers that God the creator alone has. He reveals Himself thus as someone who is of Divine origin. They should therefore have confidence in Him and trust Him in every circumstance where man is threatened and limited. That is why we too should turn to Him in confidence when we face all sorts of troubles. He can rescue us as well. Let the storms of our lives not set us up to the point where we should think that nothing could be done. Jesus can do something. Let us call on Him with trust and confidence.

Let us pray that the Lord may grant us the grace to never panic when in trouble, but rather to always turn to Jesus even in difficult situations which appear insoluble.

Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the parish office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:**

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the parish office 9-12 months prior to the celebration and talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. Please visit our website www.cathedralvi.org or call us at 340-774-0201. The Sacrament of Marriage is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please contact the parish priest if you would like a different time for your wedding. (Note that Saturday mornings are reserved for cleaning and decorating the cathedral.)

If anyone in your family is sick or shut-in, please inform the parish office so that we can pray for them and arrange to visit them. Please note that the hospital does not notify us when Catholics are in the hospital. Please call the parish office to inform us of a Catholic in the hospital who needs to have a priest visit. Funeral Masses at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral are held on the designated day at 9:30AM. **Acuda a Jesús en tiempos de dificultad**

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

La Liturgia de hoy nos ayuda a ver cómo Dios domina cada situación, incluso aquellas que podrían ser impensables. Los discípulos lo experimentan en el pasaje evangélico de hoy. (Marcos 4: 35-41)

De hecho, Jesús está cruzando el mar con sus discípulos en la barca. De repente una violenta tormenta enfurece tanto el mar que los discípulos empiezan a temer por sus vidas porque las olas rompen sobre la barca. Esta experiencia de los discípulos con Jesús en la barca es similar a la nuestra en la vida. En verdad, la vida en la tierra es como cruzar el mar, donde hay momentos de calma y también momentos de turbulencia con olas violentas que nos sacuden, nos amenazan, nos hacen temer a veces por nuestras vidas. Cuando llegan esos momentos de dificultades, a veces intentamos afrontarlos solos; olvidamos que Jesús está a nuestro lado, presente y atento. Como los discípulos del evangelio, a veces pensamos que Él está dormido y no nos presta atención ni a lo que sucede. Decimos: Dios no está atento a nuestros problemas ni a nuestras necesidades. ¿No ve Él cómo las cosas se están desmoronando en nuestras vidas?

Cuando los discípulos se dieron cuenta de que estaban indefensos y que ya no podían afrontar las dificultades del mar, se dirigieron a Jesús, lo despertaron y le dijeron: “Maestro, ¿no te importa que estemos pereciendo?” Sabían que sólo Jesús podía salvarlos en ese momento. Cuando nos encontramos en situaciones difíciles, ¿a quién acudimos? ¿Tenemos suficiente fe para acudir a Jesús en busca de ayuda? La falta de fe es lo que hizo temer a los discípulos. Por eso Jesús les preguntó: “¿Por qué están aterrorizados? ¿Aún no tenéis fe?” Es la misma falta de fe la que muchas veces nos hace temer. No confiamos lo suficiente en Dios. Por eso encontramos personas que acuden a otras iglesias que no son católicas, o a algunas sectas como la Orden Rosacruz, la masonería y otras en busca de salvación o solución fácil a sus problemas.

**Meditación** continuada

De hecho, al elegir cruzar el mar con sus discípulos, Jesús quiere mostrarles que tiene poder sobre las fuerzas de la naturaleza que el hombre teme. Al someterlos, Jesús se revela como todopoderoso y así asegura a sus discípulos que tiene poderes que sólo Dios el creador tiene. Él se revela así como alguien de origen divino. Por lo tanto, deben tener confianza en Él y confiar en Él en cada circunstancia en la que el hombre se ve amenazado y limitado. Por eso nosotros también debemos acudir a Él con confianza cuando enfrentamos todo tipo de problemas. Él también puede rescatarnos a nosotros. Que las tormentas de nuestras vidas no nos lleven al punto de pensar que no se puede hacer nada. Jesús puede hacer algo. Invoquémoslo con confianza y seguridad.

Oremos para que el Señor nos conceda la gracia de nunca entrar en pánico cuando estamos en problemas, sino de acudir siempre a Jesús incluso en situaciones difíciles que parecen insolubles.
