"Who do you say I am?"

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are celebrating today the Solemnity of St. Peter and St. Paul, two great Saints who were disciples of Jesus. We also celebrate in "grand style" the Jubilee of our Cathedral Church on the occasion of its 250th Anniversary. It is an occasion of Thanksgiving to God for that house of prayer that has been offered to us and which stands the test of time despite the destructive effects of the hurricane and of persecutions in the course of history. It has been dedicated to Sts. Peter and Paul, two great Saints who were converted sinners.

God will give him the respect and consideration which is due, whereas those who will see him as a mere man will not have much consideration for him. What about us? If Jesus were to ask us today: "Who do you say I am?" What will be our answer? Our actions and our attitude towards Jesus should show our faith in Him. May He grant us the grace to see Him and consider Him as our "Lord and our God" like Thomas and have an attitude of adoration towards Him, listening to His word and putting it into practice. It is only thus that we will deserve in

We know fully well that Peter denied Jesus three times, but later on repented and became the head of the Church, a zealous apostle who even shed his blood for Christ. He died as a martyr. As for Paul, he was a violent persecutor of the Church. He was very much opposed to Christians. It is on his way to Damascus that the Lord appeared to him whereas he was going to persecute the Christians. After his encounter with the Lord, he became totally converted. He who was persecuting the Church was going to become the zealous apostle of Jesus, working tirelessly for the spreading of the good news and for the establishment of the Church among the Gentiles or Pagan Nations. In his turn, he suffered for the sake of the Gospel, he was in prison for the faith he was spreading and died as a martyr.

It is interesting to see that both Peter and Paul were sinners who became Saints. We too are all sinners in need of conversion to become Saints. The Saints are not people who were extraordinary and without sin, but rather ordinary people like us with their own weaknesses and frailties, with their own limitations and sins, just like us. It therefore means that we too can become Saints. Let us ask God to grant us the grace of conversion in order to become like Peter and Paul by our faith and our witness to the Gospel of Christ.

Meditation (continued)

In the Gospel of today, Jesus asks His disciples who do they think that He is? This question is a fundamental one because the way we consider people determines the quality of our relationship with them. The answers of some people today show this. Some considered him as a prophet, as John the Baptist, Elijah, or Jeremiah, and not as the Son of God despite the divine actions that he was performing in their sight. That is why they could not relate with him as a divine person. We can understand why the Scribes and Pharisees did not have a great consideration for Him. Had they known that they were dealing with the son of God, that their attitude would have been different. It is Simon Peter who will reveal the true identity of Jesus by saying in answer to his question: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." This answer which Jesus said to be a revelation of his heavenly Father, was to change not only the perception of the disciples who were present, but also their way of relating with Jesus henceforth. Those who will consider him as coming from God will give him the respect and consideration which is due, whereas those who will see him as a mere man will not have much consideration for show our faith in Him. May He grant us the grace to see Him and consider Him as our "Lord and our tion towards Him, listening to His word and putting it into practice. It is only thus that we will deserve in the end to share His glory in heaven with Sts. Peter and Paul, and all the Saints forever and ever!





SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are generally held on the last Sunday of the month. Requests for a different date and time will be honored to the extent possible. Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the parish office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the parish office 9-12 months prior to the celebration and talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. Please visit our website www.cathedralvi.org or call us at 340-774-0201. The Sacrament of Marriage is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please contact the parish priest if you would like a different time for your wedding. (Note that Saturday mornings are reserved for cleaning and decorating the cathedral.)

VISITING AND ANNOINTING THE SICK:

If anyone in your family is sick or shut-in, please inform the parish office so that we can pray for them and arrange to visit them. Please note that the hospital does not notify us when Catholics are in the hospital. Please call the parish office to inform us of a Catholic in the hospital who needs to have a priest visit. Thank you!

FUNERAL MASSES:

Funeral Masses at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral are held on the designated day at 9:30AM. Please make arrangements with the Church office before the funeral home to assure availability of the date requested. The Funeral Program should read "Christian Burial" on the cover. If you would like a different time, please contact the parish priest. Viewings will not take place inside the cathedral. Funerals generally are not held on weekends (Saturday or Sunday). Thank you for your cooperation.

"¿Quién dices que soy?"

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Celebramos hoy la Solemnidad de San Pedro y San Pablo, dos grandes Santos que fueron discípulos de Jesús. Celebramos también a "gran estilo" el Jubileo de nuestra Iglesia Catedral con motivo de su 250 Aniversario. Es una ocasión de acción de gracias a Dios por esa casa de oración que se nos ha ofrecido y que resiste el paso del tiempo a pesar de los efectos destructivos del huracán y de las persecuciones a lo largo de la historia. Ha sido dedicado a los Santos. Pedro y Pablo, dos grandes Santos que fueron pecadores convertidos.

Sabemos muy bien que Pedro negó a Jesús tres veces, pero luego se arrepintió y se convirtió en cabeza de la Iglesia, un apóstol celoso que incluso derramó su sangre por Cristo. Murió como mártir. En cuanto a Pablo, fue un violento perseguidor de la Iglesia. Se oponía mucho a los cristianos. De camino a Damasco se le apareció el Señor cuando iba a perseguir a los cristianos. Después de su encuentro con el Señor, se convirtió totalmente. El que perseguía a la Iglesia iba a convertirse en el celoso apóstol de Jesús, trabajando incansablemente por la difusión de las buenas nuevas y por el establecimiento de la Iglesia entre los gentiles o naciones paganas. A su vez sufrió por causa del Evangelio, estuvo en prisión por la fe que difundía y murió como mártir.

Es interesante ver que tanto Pedro como Pablo eran pecadores que se convirtieron en santos. También nosotros somos todos pecadores y necesitamos convertirnos para convertirnos en santos. Los Santos no son personas extraordinarias y sin pecado, sino personas comunes y corrientes como nosotros, con sus propias debilidades y fragilidades, con sus propias limitaciones y pecados, como nosotros. Por tanto, significa que nosotros también podemos llegar a ser santos. Pidamos a Dios que nos conceda la gracia de la conversión para llegar a ser como Pedro y Pablo por nuestra fe y nuestro testimonio del Evangelio de Cristo.

Meditación continuada

30 de junio de 2024

En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús pregunta a sus discípulos quién creen que es Él? Esta pregunta es fundamental porque la forma en que consideramos a las personas determina la calidad de nuestra relación con ellas. Las respuestas de algunas personas hoy lo demuestran. Algunos lo consideraban un profeta, como Juan Bautista, Elías o Jeremías, y no como el Hijo de Dios a pesar de las acciones divinas que estaba realizando ante sus ojos. Por eso no podían relacionarse con él como persona divina. Podemos entender por qué los escribas y fariseos no le tenían gran consideración. Si hubieran sabido que estaban tratando con el hijo de Dios, su actitud habría sido diferente. Es Simón Pedro quien revelará la verdadera identidad de Jesús diciendo en respuesta a su pregunta: "Tú eres el Cristo, el Hijo del Dios vivo". Esta respuesta, que Jesús dijo que era una revelación de su Padre celestial, iba a cambiar no sólo la percepción de los discípulos presentes, sino también su manera de relacionarse con Jesús en adelante. Aquellos que lo consideren procedente de Dios le darán el respeto y la consideración que se merece, mientras que aquellos que lo verán como un simple hombre no le tendrán mucha consideración. ¿Qué pasa con nosotros? Si Jesús nos preguntara hoy: "¿Quién decís que soy yo?" ¿Cuál será nuestra respuesta? Nuestras acciones y nuestra actitud hacia Jesús deben mostrar nuestra fe en Él. Que Él nos conceda la gracia de verlo y considerarlo como nuestro "Señor y Dios nuestro" como Tomás y tener una actitud de adoración hacia Él, escuchando su palabra y poniéndola en práctica. 
