

Let us keep God's Law

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In every society, beginning with the family, there are laws that are established in order to preserve order. There are laws that are written and applied. We usually refer to them as positive law. But there are also some laws that are not written and that we are expected to observe out of common sense. When we do things that are not correct, our conscience tells us immediately. That is why we are always told to follow the dictates of our conscience. But we have to be careful, for we should also form our conscience well for it to tell us what is good or right, and what is bad or wrong. This formation of conscience begins in infancy. We should form the conscience of our children from their infancy if we expect them to be disciplined, to make good choices, right decisions and to behave well. That is what God does with man since the beginning of creation.

When God made man in the beginning, He gave him a law for the purpose of order and man's happiness: "eat all the fruits of the garden, except this one." That is the beginning of the law. Man was expected to keep God's law in order to be happy, but as we all know, he did not. That is how sin came into the world and the consequence of sin is death.

In the first reading from the Book of Exodus, we see that God still gives man through the people of Israel His laws. Obedience to these laws make the happiness of the people of Israel; but unfortunately, we all know that the people did not always remain faithful to God's law. That is why they lost their blessings and graces; they had many failures and miserable situations in their lives. It is the same thing with us. Sometimes, we do live difficult situations or go through difficult and sad experiences and hardships, simply because we did not respect God's law. Some of these laws do have their natural punishment, but we do not pay attention to them. When you disregard God and have other gods before whom you bow, God becomes "jealous" and inflicts punishment for the father's wickedness on the children of those who hate him. This shows that when we misbehave in life, it can have a negative influence on our children or on our descendants.

Reflection(continued)

Sometimes, we too do suffer from the negative effects of the bad behaviors of our parents and grandparents. That is why we should be careful with our life.

The other commandment which has a special blessing attached to it is: "Honor your father and your mother, that you may have a long life in the land which the Lord your God is giving you." In other words, it means that if you do not honor your parents, your father, and your mother, you will not have a long life on earth. It is important to take note of this and talk about it with our children. Our parents are those through whom God gave us life. If we want to have life, we need to obey and respect them, help them in their old age. It will be a source of blessing for us. But not all the laws are written in the commandments. We can see this clearly in the gospel message.

In fact, it is written nowhere that we shouldn't make business in church or in the temple. It is common sense that tells that we must respect the house of God as a sacred place. When we do not respect it, it is an offence. We can therefore understand Jesus when He made a whip out of cords to drive out of the temple area all those who sold oxen, sheep, and doves as well as the money changers. If Jesus were to visit us here, I think He would also behave the same way sending out all those who do not respect the sacredness, the holiness of the Church as the Temple of God: those who talk in Church anyhow, those who eat in Church, those who talk business in Church and distract others who want to pray!

During the mass of today, let us tell God that we are sorry for the many times that we have not been obeying his laws and beg for the grace to always remain faithful to His commands. Amen!

O gracious Master, infuse in our hearts the spotless light of Your Divine Wisdom and open the eyes of our mind that we may understand the teachings of Your Gospel. Instill in us also the fear of Your blessed commandments, so that having curbed all carnal desires, we may lead a spiritual life, both thinking and doing everything to please You. For You, O Christ, our God, are the enlightenment of our souls and bodies; and to You we render glory, together with Your eternal Father, and with Your all holy, life-creating Spirit, now and ever, and forever. SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are generally held on the last Sunday of the month. Requests for a different date and time will be honored to the extent possible. Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the parish office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the parish office 9-12 months prior to the celebration and talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. Please visit our website www.cathedralvi.org or call us at 340-774-0201. The Sacrament of Marriage is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please contact the parish priest if you would like a different time for your wedding. (Note that Saturday mornings are reserved for cleaning and decorating the cathedral.)

VISITING AND ANOINTING THE SICK:

If anyone in your family is sick or shut-in, please inform the parish office so that we can pray for them and arrange to visit them. Please note that the hospital does not notify us when Catholics are in the hospital. Please call the parish office to inform us of a Catholic in the hospital who needs to have a priest visit. Thank you!

FUNERAL MASSES:

Funeral Masses at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral are held on the designated day at 9:30AM. Please make arrangements with the Church office before the funeral home to assure availability of the date requested. The Funeral Program should read "Christian Burial" on the cover. If you would like a different time, please contact the parish priest. Viewings will not take place inside the cathedral. Funerals generally are not held on weekends (Saturday or Sunday). Thank you for your cooperation.

RECOMMENDED PRACTICES FOR THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

REFLEXIÓN

Guardemos la Ley de Dios

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

En toda sociedad, comenzando por la familia, existen leyes que se establecen con el fin de preservar el orden. Hay leyes que están escritas y aplicadas. Generalmente nos referimos a ellos como derecho positivo. Pero también hay algunas leyes que no están escritas y que se espera que observemos por sentido común. Cuando hacemos cosas que no son correctas, nuestra conciencia nos lo dice inmediatamente. Por eso siempre se nos dice que seguimos los dictados de nuestra conciencia. Pero tenemos que tener cuidado, porque también debemos formar bien nuestra conciencia para que nos diga qué es bueno o correcto y qué es malo o incorrecto. Esta formación de la conciencia comienza en la infancia. Debemos formar la conciencia de nuestros hijos desde su infancia si esperamos que sean disciplinados, que tomen buenas decisiones, tomen decisiones correctas y se comporten bien. Eso es lo que Dios hace con el hombre desde el principio de la creación. Cuando Dios hizo al hombre en el principio, le dio una ley con el fin de mantener el orden y la felicidad del hombre: "come todos los frutos del jardín, excepto éste". Ese es el comienzo de la ley. Se esperaba que el hombre guardara la ley de Dios para ser feliz, pero como todos sabemos, no lo hizo. Así vino el pecado al mundo y la consecuencia del pecado es la muerte.

En la primera lectura del Libro del Éxodo, vemos que Dios todavía da al hombre, a través del pueblo de Israel, Sus leyes. La obediencia a estas leyes hace la felicidad del pueblo de Israel; pero lamentablemente todos sabemos que el pueblo no siempre permaneció fiel a la ley de Dios. Por eso perdieron sus bendiciones y gracias; tuvieron muchos fracasos y situaciones miserables en sus vidas. A nosotros nos pasa lo mismo. A veces, sí vivimos situaciones difíciles o pasamos por experiencias y penurias difíciles y tristes, simplemente porque no respetamos la ley de Dios. Algunas de estas leyes sí tienen su castigo natural, pero no les prestamos atención. Cuando ignoras a Dios y tienes otros dioses ante quienes te inclinas, Dios se vuelve "celoso" e infinge castigo por la maldad del padre a los hijos de quienes lo odian. Esto demuestra que cuando nos portamos mal en la vida, esto puede tener una influencia negativa en nuestros hijos o en nuestra descendiente. A veces, nosotros también sufrimos los efectos negativos de los malos comportamientos de nuestros padres y abuelos. Por eso debemos tener cuidado con nuestra vida.

El otro mandamiento que tiene una bendición especial es: "Honra a tu padre y a tu madre, para que tengas una larga vida en la tierra que el Señor tu Dios te da". En otras palabras, significa que si no honras a tus padres, a tu padre y a tu madre, no tendrás una vida larga en la tierra. Es importante tomar nota de esto y hablar de ello con nuestros hijos. Nuestros padres son aquellos a través de quienes Dios nos dio la vida. Si queremos tener vida, debemos obedecerlos y respetarlos, ayudarlos en su vejez. Será una fuente de bendición para nosotros. Pero no todas las leyes están escritas en los mandamientos. Podemos ver esto claramente en el mensaje del evangelio.

Todos estamos comprometidos con la protección de los niños en nuestras instituciones.

Por lo tanto, podemos entender a Jesús cuando hizo un látigo con cuerdas para expulsar del área del templo a todos los que vendían bueyes, ovejas y palomas, así como a los cambistas. Si Jesús nos visitara aquí, creo que también se comportaría de la misma manera enviando a todos aquellos que no respetan la sagrabilidad, la santidad de la Iglesia como Templo de Dios: los que hablan en la Iglesia de todos modos, los que comen en la Iglesia, los que hablan de negocios en la Iglesia y distraen a los que quieren orar!

Durante la misa de hoy, digámosle a Dios que lamentamos las muchas veces que no hemos estado obedeciendo sus leyes y pidamos la gracia de permanecer siempre fieles a sus mandamientos. Amén!
