

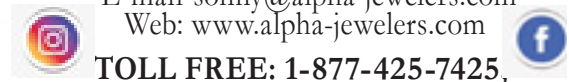

REFLECTION

Jesus is risen, let us rise with Him! Alleluia!

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In communion with the whole church, we celebrate today in joy of the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus-Christ. It is this resurrection, which is the foundation of our faith, for as St. Paul puts it: "If Christ is not risen, vain is our faith." (1 Cor 15:17) This is the good news: that Christ is risen so that we too might rise with him after death. That is the wish of every person, to live and live, and live, even after death. That is why we believe in Jesus-Christ who has power over death, and therefore over the powers of evil that ruin our lives. That is also why the news of the resurrection of Christ is good news and gives joy to the world. But before the resurrection, there was life, suffering and death.

In the first reading from the Book of the Acts of the Apostles, Peter talks about Jesus' life. He bears witness to the life of Jesus in these terms: "You know what has happened all over Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached, how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and Power. He went about doing good and healing those oppressed by the devil, for God was with him. We are witnesses of all that he did both in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem..." (Acts 10:34, 37-39) This testimony of Peter reveals the quality of the relationship between Jesus and the Father, a relation of intimacy (God was with him) and at the same time, the quality of his relation with people (he went about doing good and healing those oppressed by the devil).

Reflection(continued)

This should make us reflect on the type of testimony that will be made on us after our own death. Could people also say of us that we have been real imitators of Jesus to the point of living a life of intimacy with God in a visible manner or in a way that could be felt when people approach us? Could they also say of us that in our life, we were always doing good to people wherever we went, even to our enemies and those who persecute us? That is where lies the challenge of our Christian faith: to do good not only to our family members and friends or those that we know, but to all, even to those who hurt us, those that we don't like, those whose ways we don't like and those who hate us. To be frank it is not easy to imitate Jesus, and yet that is our call. We are called to imitate Jesus if we want to have a real life and rise with him. We should be praying for that grace. We may ask; how should we then do? We find that answer to this question in the second reading of today.

In his letter to the Colossians, St. Paul writes: "Brothers and Sisters: if then you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Think of what is above, not of what is on earth." (Col: 3:1-2) for true, we are always thinking of the things of the world and of the earth so much so that we do forget about the things of heaven. We are so worried about ourselves, our children, our families, our house, our work, our cars, our properties and so on and so forth, that we do not think about the things of heaven which St. Paul calls "what is above". How many times a day do we talk about God and the things of heaven with others? And even with God himself? Thinking about them will certainly have an impact on us, on the quality of our lives, of our relationship with God and with others. We will no longer be the same as God will be the one leading us to the point where we will say like St. Paul: "It is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me." (Gal 2:20) The resurrection of Christ will therefore have a meaning to us only if we become new people with a new way of life that shows that our life does no longer belong to us but to Christ. Let us ask Him to take hold of us and to help us rise with Him in a newness of life. Amen!

PASTORAL SERVICES FOR THE COMMUNITY

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are generally held on the last Sunday of the month. Requests for a different date and time will be honored to the extent possible. Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the parish office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the parish office 9-12 months prior to the celebration and talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. Please visit our website www.cathedralvi.org or call us at 340-774-0201. The Sacrament of Marriage is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please contact the parish priest if you would like a different time for your wedding. (Note that Saturday mornings are reserved for cleaning and decorating the cathedral.)

VISITING AND ANNOINTING THE SICK:

If anyone in your family is sick or shut-in, please inform the parish office so that we can pray for them and arrange to visit them. Please note that the hospital does not notify us when Catholics are in the hospital. Please call the parish office to inform us of a Catholic in the hospital who needs to have a priest visit. Thank you!

FUNERAL MASSES:

Funeral Masses at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral are held on the designated day at 9:30AM. Please make arrangements with the Church office before the funeral home to assure availability of the date requested. The Funeral Program should read "Christian Burial" on the cover. If you would like a different time, please contact the parish priest. Viewings will not take place inside the cathedral. Funerals generally are not held on weekends (Saturday or Sunday). Thank you for your cooperation.

REFLEXIÓN

¡Jesús ha resucitado, resucitemos con Él! ¡Aleluya!

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En comunión con toda la iglesia, celebramos hoy con gozo la Resurrección de nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Es esta resurrección la que es el fundamento de nuestra fe, porque, como dice San Pablo: “Si Cristo no ha resucitado, vana es nuestra fe” (1 Cor 15,17). Esta es la buena noticia: que Cristo es resucitado para que también nosotros resucitemos con él después de la muerte. Ese es el deseo de toda persona: vivir y vivir y vivir, incluso después de la muerte. Por eso creemos en Jesucristo que tiene poder sobre la muerte, y por tanto sobre los poderes del mal que arruinan nuestra vida. Por eso también la noticia de la resurrección de Cristo es buena noticia y da alegría al mundo. Pero antes de la resurrección había vida, sufrimiento y muerte.

En la primera lectura del Libro de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, Pedro habla de la vida de Jesús. Da testimonio de la vida de Jesús en estos términos: “Vosotros sabéis lo que ha sucedido en toda Judea, comenzando en Galilea después del bautismo que predicó Juan, cómo Dios ungió a Jesús de Nazaret con el Espíritu Santo y con poder. Anduvo haciendo el bien y sanando a los oprimidos por el diablo, porque Dios estaba con él. Somos testigos de todo lo que hizo tanto en el país de los judíos como en Jerusalén...” (Hechos 10:34, 37-39) Este testimonio de Pedro revela la calidad de la relación entre Jesús y el Padre, una relación de intimidad (Dios estaba con él) y al mismo tiempo, la calidad de su relación con las personas (andaba haciendo el bien y curando a los oprimidos por el diablo). Esto debería hacernos reflexionar sobre el tipo de testimonio que se hará sobre nosotros después de nuestra propia muerte. ¿Se podría decir también de nosotros que hemos sido verdaderos imitadores de Jesús hasta el punto de vivir una vida de intimidad con Dios de manera visible o de una manera que se puede sentir cuando la gente se acerca a nosotros? ¿Podrían decir también de nosotros que en nuestra vida siempre estábamos haciendo el bien a las personas dondequiera que fuéramos, incluso a nuestros enemigos y a quienes nos persiguen? Ahí está el desafío de nuestra fe cristiana: hacer el bien no sólo a nuestros familiares y amigos o a los que conocemos, sino a todos, incluso a los que nos hacen daño, a los que no nos gustan, a aquellos cuyos caminos que no nos gustan y los que nos odian. Para ser franco, no es fácil imitar a Jesús y, sin embargo, ese es nuestro llamado. Estamos llamados a imitar a Jesús si queremos tener una vida real y resucitar con él. Deberíamos orar por esa gracia. Podemos preguntar; ¿Cómo debemos hacer entonces? Encontramos esa respuesta a esta pregunta en la segunda lectura de hoy.

REFLEXIÓN continuada

En su carta a los Colosenses, San Pablo escribe: “Hermanos y hermanas: si, pues, habéis resucitado con Cristo, buscad lo de arriba, donde Cristo está sentado a la diestra de Dios. Piensa en lo que hay arriba, no en lo que hay en la tierra”. (Col: 3:1-2) pues en verdad siempre estamos pensando en las cosas del mundo y de la tierra, tanto que nos olvidamos de las cosas del cielo. Estamos tan preocupados por nosotros mismos, nuestros hijos, nuestras familias, nuestra casa, nuestro trabajo, nuestros automóviles, nuestras propiedades, etc., que no pensamos en las cosas del cielo que San Pablo llama “lo que está arriba”. ”. ¿Cuántas veces al día hablamos de Dios y de las cosas del cielo con los demás? ¿E incluso con Dios mismo? Pensar en ellos ciertamente tendrá un impacto en nosotros, en la calidad de nuestra vida, en nuestra relación con Dios y con los demás. Ya no seremos los mismos porque será Dios quien nos lleve al punto en que digamos como San Pablo: “Ya no soy yo quien vive, sino que es Cristo quien vive en mí”. (Gal 2:20) Por lo tanto, la resurrección de Cristo tendrá significado para nosotros sólo si nos convertimos en personas nuevas con una nueva forma de vida que muestre que nuestra vida ya no nos pertenece a nosotros sino a Cristo. Pidámosle que nos agarre y nos ayude a resucitar con El en una vida nueva. ¡Amén!
