MEDITATION

Theme: Love even our enemies

Like all parents, God dreams bigger for his children. He trusts us and he has set the bar high for us, as he points it out in the book of the Levites: "Be holy, for I, the Lord your God, am holy." Jesus also wants our behavior to be model on that of God. You will be perfect as your heavenly father is perfect. Is that too much to ask of us?

Here we are immerged in the heart of the debate which opposes in us the ideal and the reality. The ideal of perfection that Jesus proposes to us is that of love of God and neighbor. But for Christ, the neighbor, is all humans, even our enemies and the people who cause us harm. It is true that it is already difficult to love your neighbor, how then to love our enemies as Jesus wishes? In fact, Jesus does not ask us to make our enemies our friends. What matters to him is that we manage to overcome the wall of hatred that separates us from them. That we learn to see them differently, that we should recognize that they are like us, that they are his holy temple. They too need divine mercy and love.

The love of enemies is a specificity of Christianity. But forgiving trespasses, in our families, at work, and in our communities, and praying for those who foment evil against us is not easy. However, the Spirit disposes us so that we can be more like the Father. As baptized, we are called to bear witness to the power of universal love. To love one's enemies, never to despair of them, never to cease reaching out; it is to get out of the spiral of revenge and violence.

Always allow others to know that there is an opening, that another world is possible, despite everything, is to promote the rapprochement of peoples and nations. May God give us the strength to recognize him and to love like him.



SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are generally held on the last Sunday of the month. Requests for a different date and time will be honored to the extent possible. Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the parish office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the parish office 9-12 months prior to the celebration and talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. Please visit our website www.cathedralvi.org or call us at 340-774-0201. The Sacrament of Marriage is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please contact the parish priest if you would like a different time for your wedding. (Note that Saturday mornings are reserved for cleaning and decorating the cathedral.)

If anyone in your family is sick or shut-in, please inform the parish office so that we can pray for them and arrange to visit them. Please note that the hospital does not notify us when Catholics are in the hospital. Please call the parish office to inform us of a Catholic in the hospital who needs to have a priest visit. Funeral Masses at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral are held on the designated day at 9:30AM. Please make arrangements with the Church office before the funeral home to assure availability of the date requested. The Funeral Program should read "Christian Burial" on the cover. If you would like a different time, please contact the parish priest. Viewings will not take place inside the cathedral. Funerals generally are not held on weekends (Saturday or Sunday). Thank you for your cooperation.

CATECHESIS

Ash Wednesday

Ash Wednesday will be celebrated this week. Ash Wednesday is a solemn reminder of human mortality and the need for reconciliation with God and marks the beginning of the penitential Lenten season Ashes are placed on the foreheads of worshipers as a reminder of our mortality and sinfulness. The person who imposes the ashes quotes something like what God once said to Adam after he had sinned: "You are dust, and to dust you shall return" (Gen 3:19). This is the bad news of our sinfulness that prepares us to receive the good news of forgiveness in Christ. Let us look at the symbolic meaning of the gesture specific to this day which inaugurates, in reference to the forty days spent by Jesus in the desert, a period of spiritual preparation for Easter celebrations.

Ashes have two complementary meanings from the Old Testament. The first is taken up directly in one of the two formulas proposed at the time of their imposition: "dust you are, and to dust you will return" (Gn 3, 19). This affirmation is of course an invitation to humility about our mortal condition and its limitations. Addressed by God to Adam after he had eaten the forbidden fruit, these words also include a call to recognize our state of sin. This strong link between ashes and penance appears in several places in the Old Testament, in the words of Queen Esther, who "sought refuge with the Lord. She took off her ceremonial clothes and put on clothes of mourning and affliction." (Esther 4, 17) It is this gesture that we take up again for the beginning of Lent. With that gesture, we are imploring God to look upon us with his gaze of tenderness and pity, as expressed by the other formula, the one that is the most frequently used today: "Be converted" - literally-"Return to God and believe in the good news "and the mercy of He who "so loved the world that he gave his only Son" (Jn 3:16). We wish that you properly enter into this time of grace. A good and fruitful Lent to all.
