## **MEDITATION**

Before man are life and death, good and evil, whichever he chooses shall be given him." Sir 15:17.

In our first reading this weekend, we hear this maxim from our wisdom tradition from Sirach, who was a wise and experienced observer of life. He speaks of free will as a gift with consequences. He goes on to infer, 'Choose wisely.'

And in our Gospel, Jesus tells us how to choose wisely; by guarding the dispositon of our heart. Do not avoid just murder, but also avoid anger, the disposition of heart that always precedes it. Avoid not just adultery, but lust which proceeds it. Don't just avoid taking a false oath; don't even swear at all.

We call this avoiding the near occasion of sin. It is so important because if left unchecked, sin can enslave us, diminish our freedom. Sinful actions can become habits and addictions. These addictions compromise our free will.

Breaking these additions is possible, usually by going back to the root of the sin, but always with persistent work and a lot of grace of God. A good priest can help find freedom once again.

God's will is that we be free from sin so that we are free to love. So choose wisely. Choose not evil, but good; not death but life.







### The meaning of the collection:

The collection is above all a liturgical gesture that consists of an offering made during Mass by the faithful, an offering that allows them to associate themselves with the gift that Jesus Christ made of their life.

### What is the collection in church?

Offering made during masses by the faithful. Most Sunday quests remain the property of the parish and are used to cover its expenses (air conditioner, staff, maintenance, activities ...)

### Why the collection at Mass?

The collection is the offering made during Masses by the faithful; It is a vital resource for your parish that is used to cover operating costs such as air conditioning, electricity, church flowering or various pastoral activities.

### Where does the church collection money go?

The money from the collection is used by the parish to finance air conditioning and electricity costs. Donations made to the church's denarius pay for priests' salaries, lay salaries and seminarians' training.

### When is the quest for Mass?

Collections: They are done during the celebration of a sacrament (baptism, mass, marriage) or funeral.
