

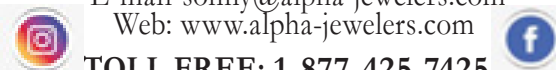

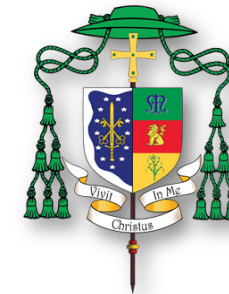

MEDITATION

REFLEXION: EPIPHANY OF the LORD

Brethren,
After the Solemnity of the Virgin Mary Mother of God, our mother the Church gives us to celebrate on this Sunday the Epiphany of the Lord. From ancient Greek epipháneia, which means appearance; manifestation, the epiphany is a religious term that refers to an episode from the Bible: “ a star appears in front of the three wise men, and guides them to the child Jesus”. This is why the catechesis of the Catholic Church defines the epiphany as “the manifestation of Jesus to the world”. In his gospel, Matthew does not describe the birth of Jesus, but he is the only one to tell of the visit of the Magi. The historical origin of the events he relates escape to us. But what is important, is the intention of the story, which is rich in symbols.

“A new light in the heavens has made known that the savior had come to redeem the world.”Yes, today, God revealed in Christ, the mystery of our salvation through the radiations of a luminous star so that all peoples may be illuminated by Him.

God always raises stars in our lives; but do we know how to recognize them? What kind of Magi will we be this year? Will we be too busy with our human duty to look up to the sky? Will there be a place for God in our busy schedules? Will we be able to distinguish the star?

As we are celebrating the epiphany of the Lord, we are invited to walk with others as church, while letting ourselves be guided by Christ, the star that illuminates the world with his unmeasurable love. Then, in return we can also be stars for our brothers and sisters, as well as all the people we meet, who are still in darkness.

Happy feast, Happy New Year 2023 and blessed new week to all under the loving gaze of our Lord Jesus Christ.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are generally held on the last Sunday of the month. Requests for a different date and time will be honored to the extent possible. Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the parish office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the parish office 9-12 months prior to the celebration and talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. Please visit our website www.cathedralvi.org or call us at 340-774-0201. The Sacrament of Marriage is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please contact the parish priest if you would like a different time for your wedding. (Note that Saturday mornings are reserved for cleaning and decorating the cathedral.)

VISITING AND ANNOINTING THE SICK:

If anyone in your family is sick or shut-in, please inform the parish office so that we can pray for them and arrange to visit them. Please note that the hospital does not notify us when Catholics are in the hospital. Please call the parish office to inform us of a Catholic in the hospital who needs to have a priest visit. Thank you!

FUNERAL MASSES:

Funeral Masses at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral are held on the designated day at 9:30AM. Please make arrangements with the Church office before the funeral home to assure availability of the date requested. The Funeral Program should read "Christian Burial" on the cover. If you would like a different time, please contact the parish priest. Viewings will not take place inside the cathedral. Funerals generally are not held on weekends (Saturday or Sunday). Thank you for your cooperation.

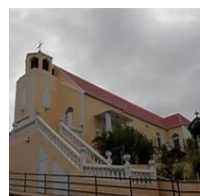

REFLEXIÓN: EPIFANÍA DEL SEÑOR

Hermanos,
Después de la solemnidad de la Virgen María Madre de Dios, nuestra madre la Iglesia nos da para celebrar en este domingo la Epifanía del Señor. Del griego antiguo epipháneia, que significa apariencia; La Epifanía es un término religioso que se refiere a un episodio de la Biblia: “una estrella aparece delante de los tres reyes magos, y los guía hacia el niño Jesús”. Por eso la catequesis de la Iglesia Católica define la epifanía como “la manifestación de Jesús al mundo”. En su evangelio, Mateo no describe el nacimiento de Jesús, pero es el único que habla de la visita de los Reyes Magos. El origen histórico de los acontecimientos que relata se nos escapa.
