

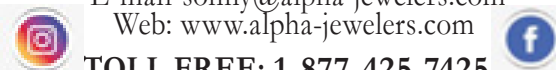

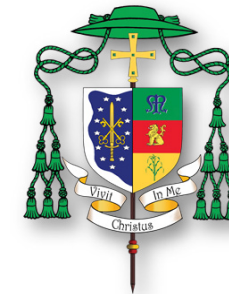

The Nativity of the Lord

Vigil: Isaiah 62:1-5; Psalm 89; Acts 13:16-17, 22-25; Matthew 1:1-25 or 1:18-25

Hundreds of years before Christ was born, Isaiah saw that a day would dawn when God's people would rejoice with delight. That day has come. Paul testifies in Acts and Matthew in his Gospel that Jesus is the Messiah, descended from Abraham and Sarah, traced back to King David, heralded by John the Baptist, conceived through the Holy Spirit, and born of Mary. Emmanuel—God with us—is named Jesus because he will be our Savior. Let us welcome him into our hearts on this holy night.

Day: Isaiah 52:7-10; Psalm 98; Hebrews 1:1-6; John 1:1-18 or 1:1-5, 9-14

God's sentinels cry out with joy, for the saving power of God has become incarnate in our world. The Word is made flesh for us on this holy day. God's word now dwells among us, bringing light, bringing truth, bringing grace, bringing peace, bringing good news, bringing salvation. Let us open our ears, our minds, and our hearts to God's extraordinary and eternal gift.

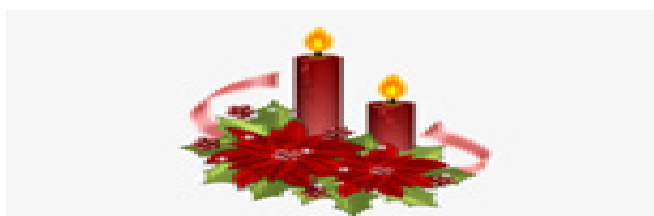

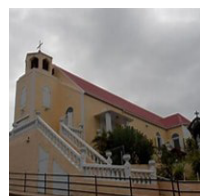
VISITING AND ANNOINTING THE SICK:

CHRISTMAS MESSAGE 2022:

Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy for all the people: Today in the city of David a Savior is born to you, who is Christ the Lord" (Lk 2:10-11). Christmas, Christmas in our lives. It is Christmas, we have been celebrating Christmas for over two thousand years. It is the same Christmas, it is the same mystery. The mystery of the incarnation. "Emmanuel, God with us", God in our lives. It is the love of God that is magnified.

This announcement Angel's is fundamental, proclaimed repeatedly every Christmas in the gospel at midnight mass, because the mystery of the birth of Jesus the Savior is realized in a mystical and mysterious way for the joy of salvation "of all people". This "today" in the angelic proclamation refers not only to that unique date in Bethlehem two thousand years ago, but also and above all to what is still happening today among us. This will continue until the end of time. The Lord Jesus is also born in our "today", and the sign to recognize him is always the one indicated by the angel: "And this is the sign that is given to you: you will find a newborn baby wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a manger" (Lk 2:12). That is to say, a fragile, defenseless little child who knows only how to cry in the face of adversity. They were waiting for the Lion of the tribe of Judah, and the Lamb of God came (cf. Rev 5:5-6)! This is our joy of the God who is close, tender, delicate, who wants to enter our lives on tiptoe, with all respect for our freedom, to accompany us to salvation not with the signs of power, but with the power of signs, to use a beautiful formulation used by Pope Francis.

This is the joy of Christmas: "Today a Savior is born to you who is Christ, the Lord." (Lk 2:11, Night Gospel). The Lord Jesus comes to us to tell us not to be afraid, to break the indifference of one another, because God, in Jesus his Son, has compromised himself with humanity wounded by sin to save us.

"How beautiful are the steps of those who seek God, on mountains, the messengers of good news, salvation and peace" (Isaiah 52:7). Let us be the messengers of this good news: "For us today, the Savior is born". It is the manifest love of "God Love", a free love, a pure grace. God could not give us anything more precious than to give his Son so that we become, through his Son, adopted sons. In the past he spoke to us through our forefathers and the prophets, today he speaks to us through his son (Heb 1:1+). Let's not reduce this Christmas to its festive, commercial and industrial celebration, but let's give it back all its spiritual consideration in the baby Jesus of the manger of Bethlehem.

May this Christmas bring you joy and prosperity and may your dreams come true. I wish you laughter, smiles and lots of joy this Christmas season. Our most affectionate thoughts for all your close and distant families during these end-of-year celebrations.

Primera lectura: Is 52: 7-10

Prorrumpen en gritos de alegría, ruinas de Jerusalén, porque el Señor rescata a su pueblo, consuela a Jerusalén. Descubre el Señor su santo brazo a la vista de todas las naciones. Segunda lectura: Hb 1: 1-6

Y aquel que es la Palabra se hizo hombre y habitó entre nosotros. Hemos visto su gloria, gloria que le corresponde como a unigénito del Padre, lleno de gracia y de verdad. Juan el Bautista dio testimonio de él, clamando: “A éste me refería cuando dije: ‘El que viene después de mí, tiene precedencia sobre mí, porque ya existía antes que yo’. De su plenitud hemos recibido todos gracia sobre gracia. Porque la ley fue dada por medio de Moisés, mientras que la gracia y la verdad vinieron por Jesucristo. A Dios nadie lo ha visto jamás.
