

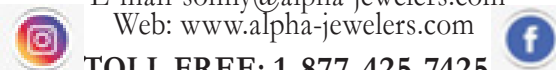

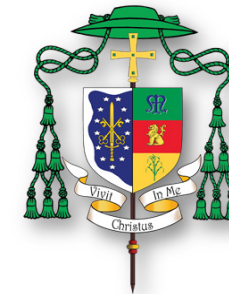

First Reading: Wisdom 11:22—12:2 The Lord has mercy on all.
 Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 145 "I will praise your name for ever, my king and my God."
 Second Reading: 2 Thessalonians 1:11—2:2 May the name of Christ be glorified in you and you in him.

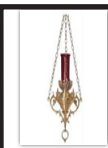

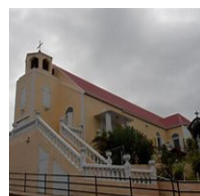

3. **ON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2022, ALL SOULS DAY**, there will be three masses at 6:45 a.m., 12:15 p.m., and a Spanish mass at 6:00 p.m. for the faithful departed. Bring candles, flowers, and wreaths to be blessed for the graves of your deceased loved ones. The deacon and priest would be available to go to the cemetery to bless graves after the 6:45 a.m. mass. Please contact the church office if you are interested.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are generally held on the last Sunday of the month. Requests for a different date and time will be honored to the extent possible. Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the parish office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the parish office 9-12 months prior to the celebration and talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. Please visit our website www.cathedralvi.org or call us at 340-774-0201. The Sacrament of Marriage is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please contact the parish priest if you would like a different time for your wedding. (Note that Saturday mornings are reserved for cleaning and decorating the cathedral.)

VISITING AND ANNOINTING THE SICK:

If anyone in your family is sick or shut-in, please inform the parish office so that we can pray for them and arrange to visit them. Please note that the hospital does not notify us when Catholics are in the hospital. Please call the parish office to inform us of a Catholic in the hospital who needs to have a priest visit. Funeral Masses at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral are held on the designated day at 9:30AM. Please make arrangements with the Church office before the funeral home to assure availability of the date requested. The Funeral Program should read "**Christian Burial**" on the cover. If you would like a different time, please contact the parish priest. Viewings will not take place inside the cathedral. Funerals generally are not held on weekends (Saturday or Sunday).
