

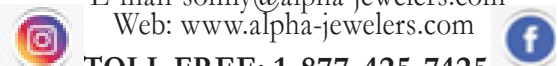

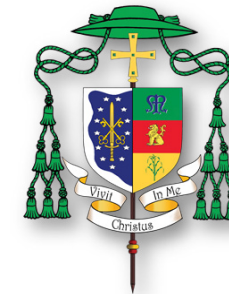

# Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading: 2 Maccabees 7:1-2, 9-14      God will raise us to live again forever.  
 Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 17      "Lord, when your glory appears, my joy will be full."  
 Second Reading: 2 Thessalonians 2:16-3:5      May the Lord encourage your hearts.  
 Gospel: Luke 20:27-38 or 20:27, 34-38      In God there is no death.

The selections from scripture that we hear today portray people whose faith in eternal life with the Lord gives them confidence during times of trial. In Maccabees, seven brothers and their mother were arrested and tortured for their faith. Saint Paul is pursued by wicked people who will do anything to stop him from preaching. Jesus is in Jerusalem now, where soon he will be arrested and sentenced to death. But the dead will rise, Jesus tells the Sadducees, for the Lord is God of the living. May this give us hope as well.

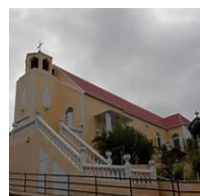

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:**

**XXXII DOMINGO ORDINARIO**

**Primera lectura: 2 Mc 7, 1-2. 9-14**

En aquellos días, arrestaron a siete hermanos junto con su madre. El rey Antíoco Epifanes los hizo azotar para obligarlos a comer carne de puerco, prohibida por la ley. Uno de ellos, hablando en nombre de todos, dijo: "¿Qué quieres saber de nosotros? Estamos dispuestos a morir antes que quebrantar la ley de nuestros padres". El rey se enfureció y lo mandó matar. Cuando el segundo de ellos estaba para morir, le dijo al rey: "Asesino, tú nos arrancas la vida presente, pero el rey del universo nos resucitará a una vida eterna, puesto que morimos por fidelidad a sus leyes". Después comenzaron a burlarse del tercero. Presentó la lengua como se lo exigieron, extendió las manos con firmeza y declaró confiadamente: "De Dios recibí estos miembros y por amor a su ley los desprecio, y de él espero recobrarlos". El rey y sus acompañantes quedaron impresionados por el valor con que aquel muchacho despreciaba los tormentos. Una vez muerto éste, sometieron al cuarto a torturas semejantes.
