UPCOMING ONLINE VIRTUS TRAINING

Protecting God's Children Version 4.0

Sunday, January 16, 2022 ~ 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm

Did you know that all diocesan clergy, religious, staff and all volunteers aged 18 and older in our parishes, schools, agencies and organizations, are required to attend a “VIRTUS: Protecting God’s Children for Adults” session?

Some examples of volunteers who need to attend a VIRTUS*Online* Training session are:

- parish staff and volunteers (including office staff, musicians, choir members, ushers, lectors, etc.)
- adults volunteering or working in our parish schools,
- catechists, CCD Instructors,
- youth group leaders,
- sport coaches, etc.

The **3-hour VIRTUS session** consists of a presentation of printed materials, videos, and group discussion. Among other things, VIRTUS attendees will learn:

- to recognize the signs and symptoms that indicate a child is being abused or exploited in some way,
- environmental factors to be aware of in the physical space of the parish or school,
- how abusers operate (on-site and via the internet...)
- easy steps one can use to help prevent child sexual abuse.

To register for the upcoming Sunday, January 16, 2022 Zoom Session, please do the following:

- Step One:** Go to www.virtusonline.org
- Step Two:** Click on First Time Registrant and follow the instructions.
- Step Three:** Select your organization (U.S. Virgin Island)
- Step Four:** Create an ID and choose a Password
- Step Five:** Provide your contact information as required. It is very important that you include your mailing address, your email address and a daytime phone number (cellular preferably).
- Step Six:** Provide the information regarding the primary location where you work or Volunteer and your occupation (teacher, CCD Instructor, etc.)
- Step Seven:** Register for the January 16 Training Session.

Even if you have already attended a VIRTUS session, you are welcome to register for a *Protecting God’s Children recertification, doing the following:*

- 1) Login, using your ID and Password. (Ask for a Password Reset if necessary, by clicking on “I NEED LOGIN HELP”)
- 2) Go to LIVE TRAINING
- 3) Choose the January 16, 2022 Training Session you want to attend.

It is very important that you PRE-REGISTER as soon as possible to ensure you receive the appropriate links and materials and that your attendance is counted.
