

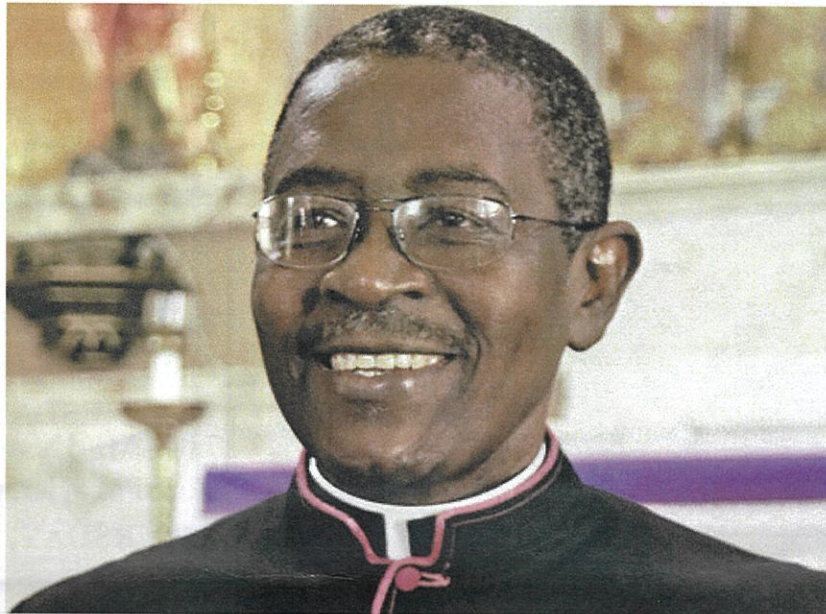

- Psalms 18 **“Lord, you have the words of everlasting life.”**
- 1 Corinthians 1:22-25 We proclaim Christ crucified, a stumbling block to many, but to those who are called, the wisdom of God.
- John 2:13-25 Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.

Today, we hear of the foundations of our faith. First, we are reminded of the commandments God gave the Chosen People to guide them in their behavior. Saint Paul explains how Jesus’ self-sacrifice was neither foolish nor weak, for in it He showed the strength of love over death. John explains that when Jesus lashes out at those who profane the temple and then declares that He will raise it up in three days, He is referring to the temple of his body. Let us listen to these readings as people of faith, finding wisdom in God’s word.

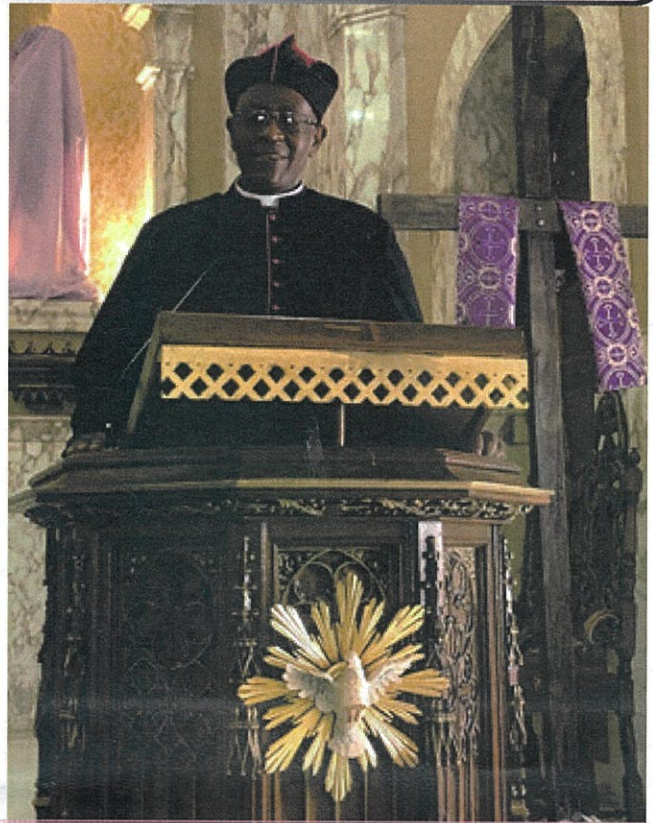

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are generally held on the last Sunday of the month. Requests for a different date and time will be honored to the extent possible. Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the Church Office 9-12 months prior to the celebration by calling 340-774-0201 or through our webpage at www.cathedralvi.org and, talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. The Sacrament of Matrimony is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please, contact the Pastor if you would like a different time for your wedding. (Note that Saturday mornings are reserved for cleaning and decorating the church.)

Funeral Masses at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral are held on the designated day at 9:30AM. The Funeral Program should read "**Christian Burial**".
