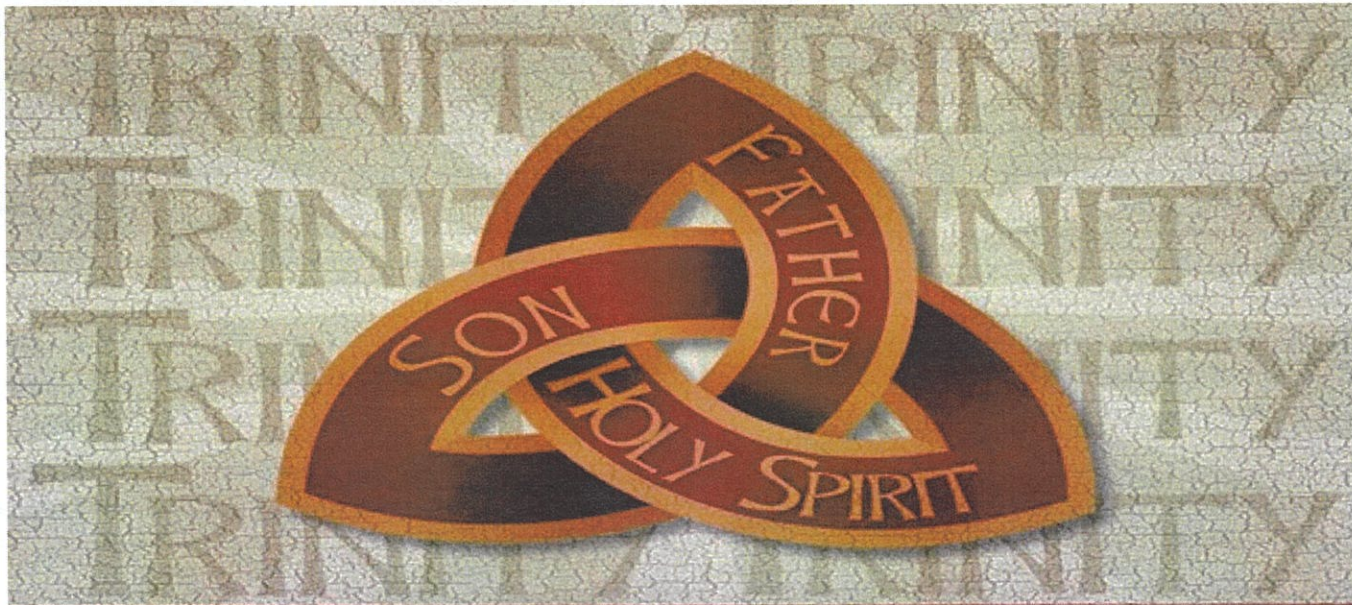

First Reading: Deuteronomy 4:32-34,39-40 The Lord is God in the heavens above and on earth below and there is no other.

Second Reading: Romans 8:14-17

You received a Spirit of adoption, through whom we cry, “Abba Father!”

Gospel: Matthew 28:16-20

Baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

As he says farewell to his disciples, Jesus instructs them to baptize “in the name of Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” Nearly twenty full centuries later we were baptized with the same words. God the Father, whom Moses extols in the first reading, God the Son, who calls us to discipleship in the Gospel, and God the Holy Spirit, whom Paul says bears witness to our adoption as children of God, mark our identity as Christians. We are reminded of this every time we make the sign of the cross. Listening to God’s holy word, let us reflect on the blessings we receive from the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

LA SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD

ENTRADA:

La solemnidad de la Trinidad se celebra ya dentro del tiempo ordinario, que reiniciamos en la semana décima. Ha terminado el tiempo de Pascua y Pentecostés fue la última celebración de ese tiempo de gloria. La liturgia de hoy guarda una cierta relación con la festividad anterior, en la que honrábamos al Espíritu Santo. El misterio de la Trinidad es uno de los más hondos de nuestras creencias y una dimensión de Dios que Jesús de Nazaret nos enseñó. Para nosotros, aquí y ahora -y dicho con la mayor sencillez y humildad- el Dios trinitario no es Dios solitario y solo. Es un Dios con familia, surgida de un acto infinito de amor, porque Dios es amor. La festividad de la Trinidad en la Iglesia es antigua, procede del siglo X. Y en 1331 se incluyó en el almanaque romano con materiales litúrgicos muy parecidos a los que hoy empleamos. Recibamos al celebrante de la Misa mientras cantamos.

PRIMERA LECTURA:

El texto del Libro del Deuteronomio, que escucharemos hoy como primera lectura, confirma que Dios es uno solo, que es único. No hay otro. Moisés se lo enseñó al pueblo elegido. Y nosotros adoramos a un solo Dios que se manifiesta en tres personas. Jesús ha perfeccionado el mensaje de Moisés. Escuchemos.

SALMO RESPONSORIAL: 32

“DICHOSA LA NACIÓN CUYO DIOS ES EL SEÑOR.”

SEGUNDA LECTURA:

El breve texto de la Carta del Apóstol San Pablo a los Romanos contiene una importante definición trinitaria. Nos va a decir Pablo de Tarso que el Espíritu nos hace exclamar ¡Abba, Padre! que es como Jesús llamaba a Dios y nos muestra que somos también hijos y herederos de la gloria.

EVANGELIO:

El Evangelio de Mateo nos muestra una de las apariciones en Galilea y las palabras de Jesús constituyen su testamento para todos sus seguidores, no solo para los Apóstoles. Hemos de llevar su palabra hasta los confines del Universo y sabemos que Él, el Señor, estará con nosotros hasta el final de los siglos. Recibamos este mensaje con la aclamación del Aleluya.

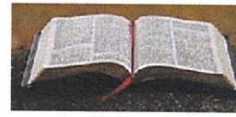

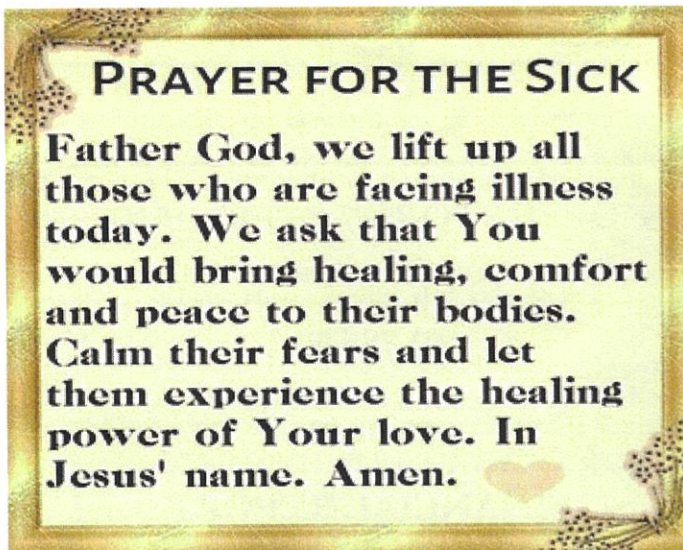

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are generally held on the last Sunday of the month. Requests for a different date and time will be honored to the extent possible. Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the Church Office 9-12 months prior to the celebration by calling 340-774-0201 or through our webpage at www.cathedralvi.org and, talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. The Sacrament of Matrimony is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please, contact the Pastor if you would like a different time for your wedding. (Note that Saturday mornings are reserved for cleaning and decorating the church.)

FUNERAL MASSES:

Funeral Masses at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral are held on the designated day at 9:30AM. The Funeral Program should read “**Christian Burial**”. If you would like a different time, please contact the pastor. Viewings will not take place inside the Cathedral. Funerals are not generally held on weekends (Saturday or Sunday). Thank you for your cooperation.
