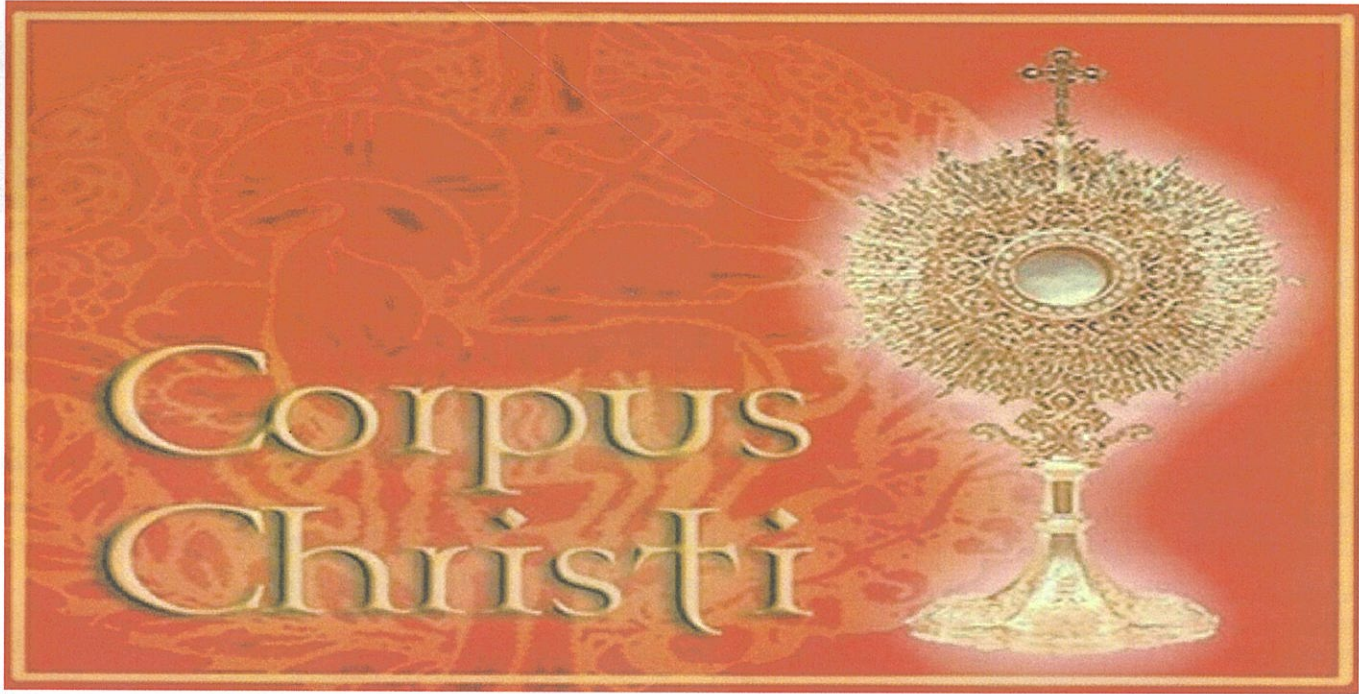

# CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY

First Reading: Exodus 24:3-8      This is the blood of the covenant that the Lord has made with you.  
 Psalm 116      **“I will take the cup of salvation, and call on the name of the Lord.”**  
 Second Reading: Hebrew 9:11-15      The blood of Christ will cleanse our consciences.  
 Gospel: Mark 14:12-16,22-26      This is my body. This is my blood of the covenant.

Blood was used by Moses and the Chosen People to seal the covenant God has made with them. Centuries later, Jesus used his own blood -the blood he offered his disciples, the blood he would freely shed on the cross- to seal the new covenant he made with those in need of redemption, with all of us. In today's psalm we sing together, "I will take the cup of salvation, and call on the name of the Lord." As we deepen our appreciation of the blood we share, let us commit to taking the cup Jesus offers us and calling upon the name of the Lord.

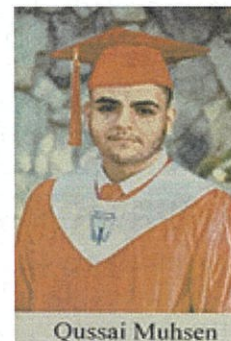

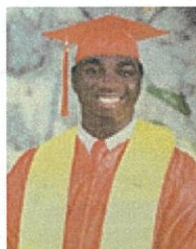

## CORPUS CHRISTI

### ENTRADA:

El año litúrgico se cierra hoy con los esplendores de la fiesta de Nuestro Señor Jesús, Rey del Universo. La institución de esta fiesta es relativamente moderna: la proclamó el Papa Pío XI, al finalizar el año santo de 1925, para expresar que Jesús está en el principio y en la plenitud de nuestra fe. Después del Concilio Vaticano II (1965) dicha fiesta se celebra el último domingo del tiempo ordinario.

La liturgia de hoy contribuye a darnos un cuadro bastante completo del sentido de la realeza de Cristo, que no es puramente la afirmación de su soberanía y su dominio sobre los seres humanos y sobre las cosas, sino sobre todo una afirmación de su amor. Su reinado es un reinado participativo, al que invita a todos los creyentes.

Dentro de poco escucharemos la primera lectura y ella el profeta Ezequiel nos presenta a Dios como un pastor bondadoso, una imagen que Jesús recogerá para presentársenos a sí mismo como nuestro Buen Pastor.

### SEGUNDA LECTURA:

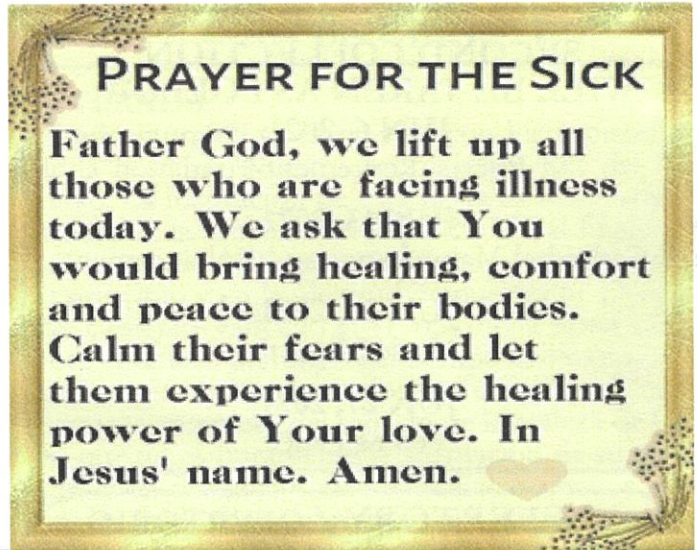

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:**

Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:**

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the Church Office 9-12 months prior to the celebration by calling 340-774-0201 or through our webpage at [www.cathedralvi.org](http://www.cathedralvi.org) and, talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. The Sacrament of Matrimony is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please, contact the Pastor if you would like a different time for your wedding.
