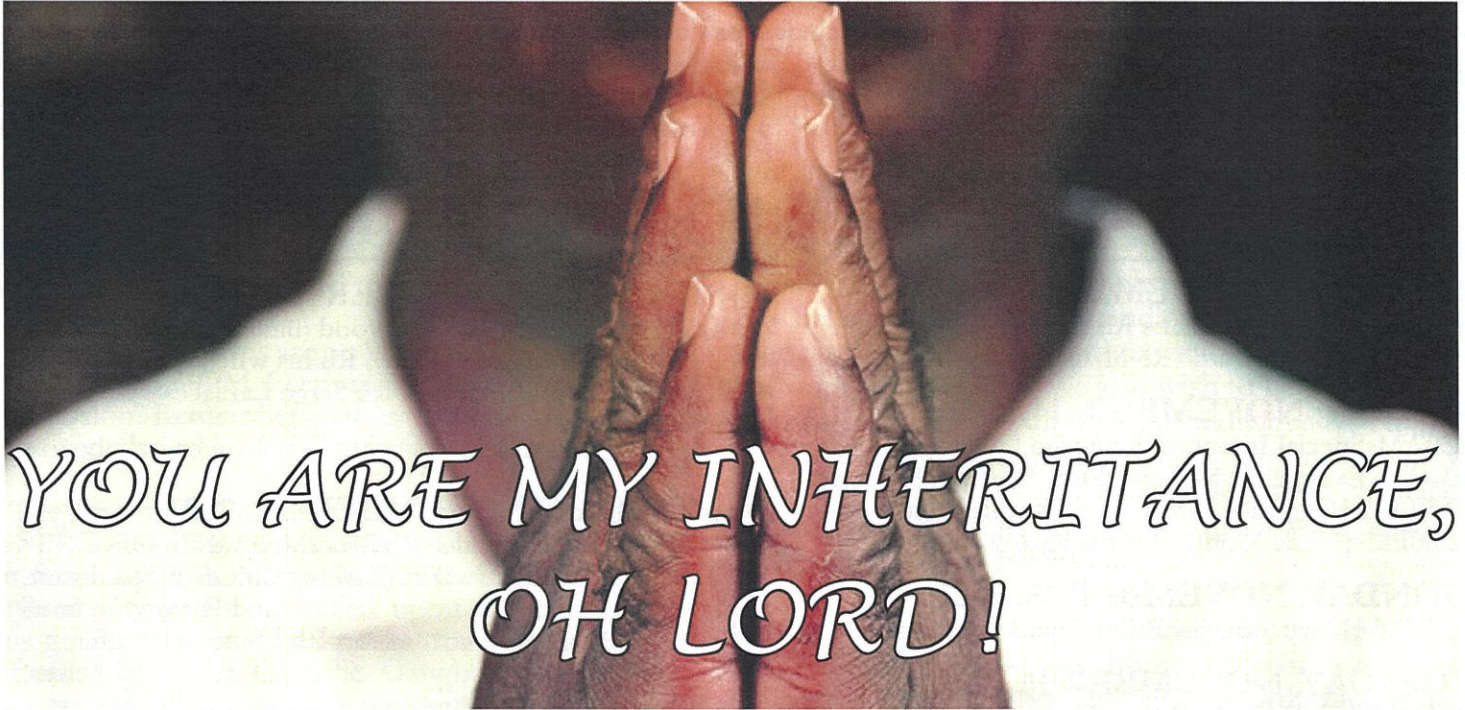

Let today’s readings remind us always to remain vigilant, for we cannot know the day nor the hour.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

* On Saturday, November 27th, 10:00AM, there shall be a joined Parish Holy Mass for the dead in the Church instead of the cemetery as we have previously said. This shall be to round up our praying for the dead this month of November. Offer your intentions for your dear ones who have died. These intentions shall all be taken on that day. On that day there shall also be a special offertory to support the ordinary running of the Parish. Thank you for your understanding.

* Remember that on Tuesdays there is Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, the members of the Legion of Mary group and the Catholic daughters of America, should arrange and patronize this adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. We mean that they should sign in for the hours they shall be there as members of these groups. Let us intensify prayers in our Parish. The leaders of these groups should contact the Rector for more detail explanation.

* Weekly Confessions are on Wednesdays at 11:30AM and Saturdays at 3:30PM. Let us make use of the Sacrament of Confession. Remember that as you go for Communion, you need also to go for Confession regularly.

* The first meeting of the US Catholic Women Council in SPPC – St. Thomas shall be held in the SPPC Church on Saturday 20th November 2021 at 9:00AM prompt. Interested women are called upon to come and begin this group. It should be known that it is another group different from the Catholic Daughters of America. If you are already in another women's group, it does not stop you from being a member. Membership however is by free choice.

* Monday, 22nd of November, 2021, is the feast day of St. Cecilia the patron saint of choirs. We would like that at 4:30PM all those who sing at the choirs should come for Holy Mass. All those who sing should take note.

* Thanksgiving this year will be on the 25th of November 2021. We shall celebrate it as usual. Holy Mass shall be at 9:00AM. Please purchase the thanksgiving Raffle tickets. On this Thanksgiving Day each individual or family is asked to bring in their thanksgiving gift in cash or kind to support the parish. Each family or individual with their offertory gifts shall process to the altar to offer it to God. The priest shall give a special blessing to those who come up with their gifts. Come along with your gift in Cash or Kind to support the ordinary running of the parish before you go and celebrate your thanksgiving at home.

* From Sunday, the 5th of December 2021 at 10:00AM in SPPC School, we shall begin the Bible Study; Bible Sharing and Bible Prayer seminars in a bit to help Christians' understanding of what the Bible is, how to read the Bible and to establish Bible Sharing groups in the Parish. We also wish to help individual Christians to pray with the Bible individually at home or elsewhere. Interested persons are invited every Sunday, starting from Sunday, December 5, 2021. Bring your Bible along. Thank you for your positive response. This is for adults.

* To prepare well for Christmas 2021, there shall be a Penitential Service for both the Spanish and the English Communities on Saturday 4th December 2021 at 10:00AM prompt. A Penitential Service is a bible service that helps Christians to inwardly go into their lives and examine themselves well and then go for confession. This is always followed by individual Confession. Prepare yourselves spiritually for Christmas 2021.

3ER DOMINGO ORDINARIO

PRIMERA LECTURA:

En aquel tiempo, se levantará Miguel, el gran príncipe que defiende a tu pueblo.

SEGUNDA LECTURA:

Hermanos: En la antigua alianza los sacerdotes ofrecían en el templo, diariamente y de pie, los mismos sacrificios, que no podían perdonar los pecados. EVANGELIO:

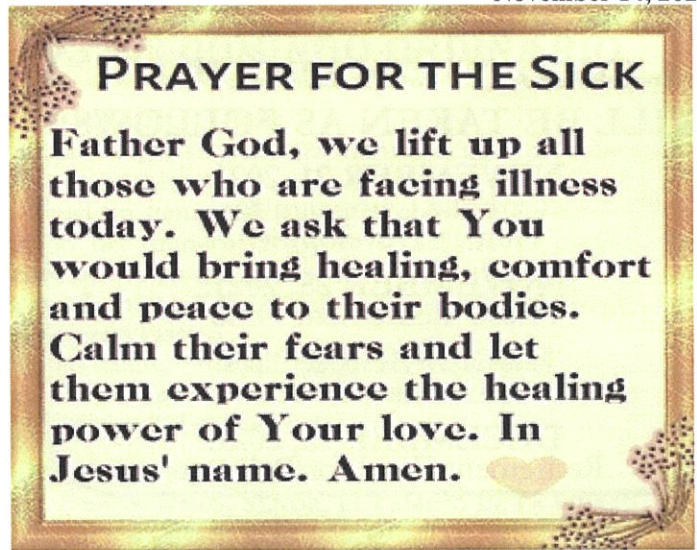

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are generally held on the last Sunday of the month. Requests for a different date and time will be honored to the extent possible. Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Anyone wishing to have his or her wedding celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral must contact the Church Office 9-12 months prior to the celebration and talk to a priest for pre-wedding counseling. Please visit our website www.cathedralvi.org or call us at 340-774-0201.

The Sacrament of Matrimony is generally celebrated on a Saturday between the hours of 11:00AM and 2:00PM. Please contact the pastor if you would like a different time for your wedding. (Note that Saturday mornings are reserved for cleaning and decorating the church.)

FUNERAL MASSES:

Funeral Masses at Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral are held on the designated day at 9:30AM. The Funeral Program should read "Christian Burial" on the cover. If you would like a different time, please contact the pastor. Viewings will not take place inside the Cathedral. Funerals generally are not held on weekends (Saturday or Sunday). Offertory collections for the support of the church shall be done henceforth for Funeral Masses or Services. Thank you for your cooperation.
