Scipio Town Council Minutes of Meeting September 19th, 2024- 7pm

Prayer & Pledge: Tom offered the prayer; the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Richard

- 1. **Minutes of August Meeting:** Council looked over minutes. Richard made a motion to accept the minutes, 2nd by Bryce. All in favor.
- 2. **Invoices and Receipts -August-** Linda went over these. Council had a copy to look at. There was a 15,000 transfer from Xpress bill pay for water payments. Linda submitted \$500 for reimbursement to county for the 24th. Linda had a question if the nitrate sample was monthly now and Richard said yes, the states mandated it. Bryce made a motion to accept, 2nd by Richard. All in favor.
- 3. Ambulance: Put in for a grant and got \$60,924. 4 people are taking the EMS classes. That money will help pay for that and they will get a stipend. They will also get a one-time retainage bonus of \$7,500 for those who stay on.
- 4. **Fire department:** Casey Draper reported that fire prevention week is the 6-12 of October. They will probably have the town fire activity on a Monday night.
- 5. **Ensign:** The lead and copper reports is due by October 16th. They can help us finish it.
- 6. **Water Department:** Richard reported that the state came to check the sanitary sources, springs, tanks etc. Results were very good. They were pleased with the system. Only had a few minor fixes and got them taken care of.
- 7. **Streets/Fitness Center**: Bryce asked of the possibility to get new Christmas lights for the streets. He had a book with different designs for council to look at. Also got the fitness center parts on warranty to fix what had broken.
- 8. Parks & Cemetery: Tabled-Tom said we need to blow out the system and winterize it.
- 9. Events & Museum: Tabled
- 10. Mayor: Tom reported that he has been working with R6 to put in with CIB for radial water meters.
- 11. **Dogs in Town:** Barking dogs have been causing a problem for people. Talked about implementing a dog tax again. Will check with other communities. There was a good write up on the Scipio web page.
- 12. Public Comment: None
