Minutes of Meeting

October 20th, 2022- 7pm

Members present: Mayor: Tom Memmott- Council Members: Jim Winget, Richard Probert, Casey Hatch, absent Bryce Monroe

Present: Clerk- Rebecca Bond, Treasurer- Linda Stephenson

Prayer & Pledge: Casey Hatch offered the prayer; the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Tom.

- 1. Minutes of September Meeting:** These were read aloud by Rebecca. Casey made a motion to accept the minutes, 2nd by Jim. All in favor.
- 2. Invoices and Receipts for August & September:** Linda went over these. Council had a copy to look at. Linda asked if it was ok to transfer capital outlay for the streets, Tom said it was ok. Richard made a motion to accept August invoice and receipts, 2nd by Casey H-all in favor. She then went over September, and said the big check to Rasmussen's was for the streets, and landfill was 16,000. Jim made a motion, 2nd by Casey H. All in favor.
- 3. Ambulance:** No one present
- 4. Fire department:** Casey reported that the fire prevention activity was good. Asked if they would like to make it an annual thing. Mentioned that some community's make it a bigger event like doing a chili cook off, or other things to involve people. Council was in favor of making it an annual event. He also reported that last night at the fire district meeting they approved the 2023 capital purchases, he submitted for \$6,000 for a thermal energy camera and hazardous spill kit. These things could also be used by the ambulance department. Also, fire restrictions have been lifted.
- 5. Water Department:** Kurt with Ensign gave an update on drainage study- they submitted it to UDOT, and once they approve it, we can get the payment submitted to the town. Also, the 200 East water project and fire flow to complete the loop. Jacksons gave a bid for \$175,000. They discussed eliminating a few things to get cost down. The budget for this project is \$140,000. Kurt said we need to make a decision tonight if council is in favor of using Jacksons, council voted – all in favor.
- 6. Streets/Fitness Center:** Tom reported that there were 8 street lights out that have been repaired by Rocky Mountain Power.
- 7. Parks & Cemetery:** Jim reported he got the new sign for the park by the fire house. He will try to get it up next week. Also, it took 6 hours to blow out the sprinkler lines with his air compressor to winterize them at the cemetery.
- 8. Events:** Casey H. reported that the Halloween party will be at the community center at 6:30 on the 31st and they will have a chili dinner and corn dogs, and kids will be trick or treating around town.
- 9. Mayor –** Tom reported on the museum update that carpet is in and they will be doing molding. Also, got the tree cut down to the north of the pioneer museum by Penny's -cost was \$2,000.

10. **Council Assignments:** Tom would like to add the fire house and museum on to Casey H, assignments along with events. This will be to check and make sure maintenance on the building's is done.
11. **American Legion:** We have donated every year and need approval from council to donate \$100 for this year, council voted- All in favor. Linda will send them a check.
12. **Land Discussion:** There is a piece of land that is 21 ft X 50 ft behind the old café on State St. that the town owns. The people that bought the house are interested in buying it. The price was estimated to be between \$500 to \$1,000 for it.
13. **New and Old:** Rental of the community center can only be up to 6 months in advance. Cost is \$25 for up to 5hrs, \$75 for an all-day event like a wedding or boutique. Linda will put a check list on the fridge of clean up duties.
14. **Public Comment:** None
15. **Adjourn:** Casey H. made motion to adjourn, 2nd by Jim. All in favor. Time was 8:06 pm.
