



You Now Have a Voice in Harrisburg

There is approximately 20 state associations of elected county and municipal officials. Now you, the Judges and Inspectors of Elections have your state association - the Pennsylvania State Association of Election Board Officers (PSAEBO).

If you are an elected or court-appointed Judge or Inspector of Elections, you automatically become a voting member of PSAEBO for the balance of your term. You can go to electionboard.org for more information.

Interested in Serving as County Chairman and Chairman-Elect

Per the PSAEBO bylaws, all Judges and Inspectors of Elections within a County consist of the County Caucus, led by a County Chairman and County Chairman-Elect. The County Caucus and the County Chairman and Chairman-Elect facilitate dialogue between the County and each of you. The County Election Board designates the County Chairman and Chairman-Elect, who must be of opposite political parties. Once the County Chairman's term expires, the County Chairman-Elect automatically becomes County Chairman, and the County Election Board appoints a new County Chairman-Elect. All County Chairmen and County Chairmen-Elect elect the State Chairman and State Chairman-Elect, along with three regional Directors.
