Pages 3 & 4—4-H Leadership, Community Service, 4-H Promotional Activities and Other Activities and Achievements

Pages 5 & 6—4-H Event Record and 4-H Banquet Awards

Project Report Pages—Update current 4-H Project Report form(s) for a minimum of one project in which you are enrolled. Project forms are also required to show completion of club talks or public presentation. The project report pages are placed in the same order in which you have them listed on page one of the Annual Report.

Financial Summary Statement— If this is your first year in any live animal project area, you are required to complete a financial statement for that animal. Otherwise, you need a financial statement for another project or item.

4-H Story—This is your personal reflection on your 4-H year.

Clippings and Photos—Do them your way!

Unused Project Report Forms—These are project forms you have started other years but did not work on this year. Just place them after your Clippings and Photos.
