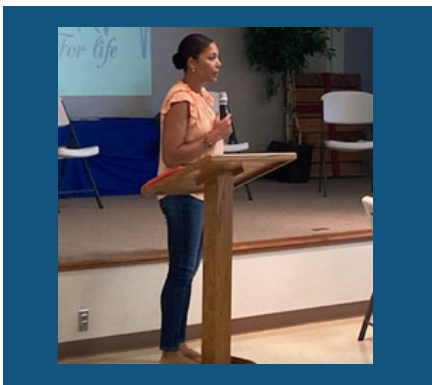
COMMUNITY PARTNERS
