



Mansfield Target Shooting Team Code of Conduct

Code of Conduct:

As a Mansfield Target Shooting Team Participant, I will:

1. Follow Mansfield ISD Student Code of Conduct
2. Will be eligible to participate under UIL Rules and Regulations
3. Eye and ear protection are mandatory and must be worn on and in the immediate vicinity of the shooting field
4. Participants must be properly dressed at all practices and competitions. Attire must follow the MISD dress code AND include long pants and closed toed shoes. A cap/hat is recommended. A shooting vest or pouch must be used during practice and competition
5. Treat all people and property with respect, courtesy, consideration and compassion. Avoid and prevent put-downs, insults, name calling, swearing and other language or nonverbal conduct likely to offend, hurt or set a bad example
6. Teach and foster teamwork and discourage selfishness. Practice fair-mindedness by being open to ideas, suggestions and opinions of others
7. Must follow the directive of the coaches at all times
8. No horseplay will be tolerated
9. Guns must remain open and empty until a shooter enters a station
10. Gun muzzles must not be rested upon or pointed toward any portion of the shooter or other individual
11. The use of cell phones will not be allowed during practice and competitions
12. Participants must follow rules of shooting range at all times
13. All guns and ammo must be approved by coaches
14. Reloaded ammunition is not allowed in practice or competition
15. Wear team apparel at all competitions

As a Mansfield Target Shooting Team Parent/Guardian, I will:

1. Firing Line Boundaries – Parents/Spectators are not allowed beyond designated boundaries. The firing line boundary for trap is behind the gun rack/ score bench.
2. Be a positive supporter of your participant and other team participants, both at practice and on the competition field
3. Support the decisions of the coaches
4. Abide by gun safety rules at all times
5. No alcohol, smoking or illegal substances (or be under the influence) are permitted at practice or competitions

If asked by a coach to assist during practice and competitions, I will

1. Be approved by MISD Volunteer procedures including a background check, <https://www.mansfieldisd.org/page.cfm?p=6001>

2. Be kind, courteous and patient with all participants
3. No alcohol, smoking or illegal substances (or be under the influence) are permitted at practice or competitions
4. Follow the directions of the coaches
5. Abide by gun safety rules at all times

Failure to follow the Mansfield Target Shooting Team could result in the following consequences:

- Verbal warning
- Removal from practice and/or competition
- Removal from team
