League and Cup Rules Sheet that all Clubs must adhere to.

Dear Secretary

Non-compliance with this rule will result in disqualification from the competition.

No player who has played for a Welsh League Club or WW Premier League Club's First Team after the 31st of August will be allowed to play in any of the Swansea Senior League Cup Competitions.

No player who has played in their respective League Cup Competitions, be it the Welsh League or the Premier League Cup, can play in the SSAFL Cup Competitions.

A player who is between the ages of 16 and 19 by the 1st of September will be allowed to play up to and including Three First-Team matches as a Trialist with a Welsh League or Premier League Club; if the player is 19 after the 1st of September, then he will not be eligible to play in the SSAFL Cup Competitions.

A player who plays for a Welsh League Club in their Reserve Division, if he has not played a First Team match or played for his Club in their Cup competition, will then be eligible to play in the SSAFL Cup Competitions.

A player cannot drop straight down to a Club's third Team. It must be to the 2nd Team unless injured, but the First Team must play a match before he is allowed to play for a Third Team.

The SSAFL Cup Competitions are invitational only, and you will only be invited to enter the SSAFL Cup Competitions after agreeing, like all Clubs in the SSAFL, to our Cup Rules.

If a Goalkeeper is cup-tied with any reserve Team, he is the only player allowed to move up to the next Senior Team in His Club, but cannot return to play again with the First Team He was Cup-tied with and **can only play in Goals at all Times.**
