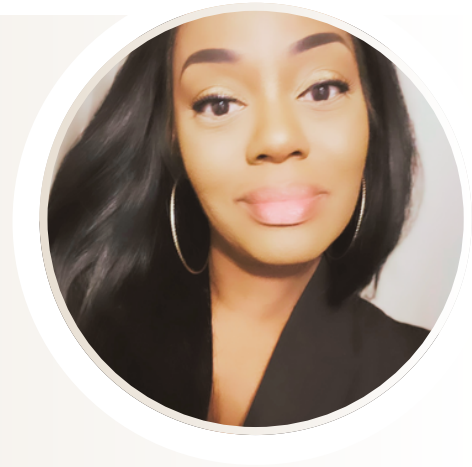


From the Editor.
