

## 4.1 Frequently used terms

- 1. Structure of nail:
  - Cuticle: Dead skin at the base of a fingernail or toenail. . Lunula: The white area at the base of a fingernail
  - Nail wall: Fold of the skin overlapping the lateral and proximal margins of the nail
  - Free edge: White coloured scaly portion of a nail
    Nail plate: The hard and translucent portion of the nail, composed
    of keratin
  - 2. Manicure: a Latin word that means Hands Care
  - 3. Shapes of nails: Forms of nail are oval, round, square
  - 4. Cuticle softener: The cream used for softening cuticle of nails during Manicure and Pedicure
  - 5. Pedicure: care of foot, legs and toenails
  - 6. Epilation: Removal of hair with its root
  - 7. Depilation: Removal of hair through application of hair removal creams, razor and electronic ra
  - 7. Threading: Removal of fine hair with the help of thread8.

Wax: used for epilation procedure.

- **9.Epidermis:** outer layer of skin on which treatments are conducted.
- 10. Dermis: Lies just below Epidermis
- 11. Normal skin: The fine, even texturedskin surface that is supple and smooth.
- 12. Dry skin: Parched in appearance and has tendency to flake easily
- 13. Oily or Greasy skin: Skin that over secretes sebum through its oil glands, making the surfaceoily
- **14. Combination skin:** It is the most common skin type, where some of its part is dry and some isoily.
- **15. Foundation cream:** The base makeup that is applied to bring an uniform and accentuated colorto the skin.
- 16. Eye shadows: Make up used on eyes
- 17. Concealer: Make up used for hiding dark spots, pimples, under eye dark circles
- 18. Autoclaving: most used sterilization process
- 19. Disinfection: process of killing the majority of Pathogenic Microorganisms
- 20. Hazard: situation that is potentially harmful
- 21. Risk: The chances for harm
- **22. Precautionary measures:** Measures to reduce the chances of harm or risk
- 23. Manufacturer's guidelines: Guidelines provided by the manufacturer on the products regardingits use, caution etc.

- 24. Ventilation: System for fresh airflow to a building
- **25. Contraindication:** A health condition where some formand even harmful to the person nature and is being used in Salon
- **26. Contra actions:** An unforeseen health effect that occurs during or after a treatment
- 27. MSDS: Material Safety Data Sheet, used for keeping records of the things which are hazardous in nature and is Being used in Salon.
