



Learn & Earn Program

Jansakhi is a women empowerment initiative by the Larsen & Toubro Public Charitable Trust and the Naik Charitable Trust, implemented at the Anil Naik Technical Training Centre (ANTTC). The program focuses on empowering women in Kharel Village and surrounding rural communities by equipping them with the skills and opportunities needed to lead

independent, dignified lives

The program follows a "Learn and Earn" model. Women enrolled in the Apparel trade undergo 4 months of structured classroom training at ANTTC, followed by 2 months of On-the-Job Training (OJT) under the Jansakhi program. During OJT, trainees gain hands-on experience in realtime production environments, enabling them to earn while they learn. This approach bridges the gap between education and employment, enhancing technical skills and building confidence. Alongside training, Jansakhi also offers business mentorship, income-generating opportunities, and community empowerment support.

By combining practical training with livelihood support, Jansakhi lays the foundation for economic self-reliance, entrepreneurship, and sustainable rural development.




