

How this activity/project relates to GOD

Q: How do you think God feels about oil painting?

[When we oil paint, we exercise our image-bearing quality as human beings made in His likeness and image, which must give Him some sense of pleasure...When we oil paint, we can bring joy and blessing to other people, and this must please God...When we oil paint well, we imitate God and glorify Him, which must be a source of joy to Him...]

How this activity/project relates to CREATION

Q: What effects might various unseen spiritual forces have on oil painting?

[The Holy Spirit can provide inspiration for our painting, but demons may also influence our painting, which should cause us to take care where we get our ideas for what to put on canvas....]

How this activity/project relates to HUMANITY

Q: How has a Christian view of oil painting affected culture?

[Oil painting that truly imitates God and brings glory to Him has been a blessing to many nations through history...Oil painting that glorifies God can inspire and educate nations...]
