1: Think of an activity you want to connect with the Biblical Worldview, and write this activity inside the bubble shown in the center of the blank area below.

2: Think of aspects of the Biblical “Big Picture” that have a particular connection with your activity. (Use may use the “96 Biblical Worldview Truths” to get some ideas.) Write these “connections” in “bubbles” around the center circle.

3: On the next page, write down some ways you could apply the biblical “connections” (identified in step 2) to your activity. (Pray! Ask God for help. Talk it over with someone.)

4: Think about any preparations you may need to do in order to be successful. (Is there any training you need to have? Any research you need to do? Any people you need to talk to?) Write these things down next.

5: Finally, write some specific action steps you will to take to turn your activity into an *Awesome Activity* that connects with the “bigger picture” of a Biblical Worldview!

I believe it is pleasing to God for humans to treat animals in kind and healthy ways. [Ex. 20:10 ...the seventh day is a Sabbath...you shall not do any work...nor your animals...; Prov. 12:10 A righteous man cares for the needs of his animal... Deut. 22:4 “You shall not see your brother’s donkey or his ox fall down along the road, and hide yourself from them; you shall surely help him lift them up again.”]

Some ways I could see myself applying Biblical Truths (shown in the outer bubbles) to my activity (shown in the middle circle):

I could see myself discouraging abusive behavior toward animals among all British citizens, and encourage positive behavior toward animals.

I could see myself making my own home a refuge for animals in need.

Some skills I must develop (or preparation I must make) in order to succeed:

I must examine the degree and extent to which cruelty to animals is a problem in Great Britain, help facilitate appropriate research in this area, and develop fitting responses.

I must convince the public and my peers in Parliament that this problem needs to be addressed.

Action steps I will take:

I will appropriate the necessary funding for research and mass communications in next year's budget.

I will help write legislation that addresses the needs by within the next 18 months.

I will give at least one speech per quarter on this topic, starting now.

I will work with others to establish a society called, "The Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals" within 3 years.
