Constitution and By-Laws

of the

American Academy of Dental Science.

Instituted in Boston.

October 19 1867.

# Preamble.

In view of the great importance of the art of Dentistry to the human race, and for the purpose of promoting the theoretical and practical knowledge of the same, as well as for elevating the standard of the science, and the requirements of practitioners of the profession, we, the undersigned, do hereby agree to establish an institution for cultivating and advancing a knowledge of Dentistry among its members, subject to the following Constitution, and to such By-Laws as shall from time to time be adopted.

# Constitution.

Article 1. The Institution shall be called the  
"American Academy of Dental Science."

Article 2. The officers of the Academy shall consist  
of a President, Vice-President, Recording Secretary  
and Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, Librarian and  
a Board of three Censors; all to be chosen annually  
by ballot, and to hold their respective offices for the  
year next ensuing their election.

Article 3. The Academy shall consist of Active,  
Associate, and Honorary Members, who shall be styled



Fellows. The Active Fellows shall be residents of Massachusetts, who shall have received the degree of Doctor of Medicine, or Doctor of Dental Surgery in some college in good standing, and shall have pursued the study of Dentistry under the instruction of an approved Dental practitioner. This shall not preclude the admission of other practitioners who, after a special and satisfactory examination by the Board of Censors, as to their personal and professional qualifications and character, shall be recommended to the Academy for membership.

The Associate Fellows shall be non-residents of Massachusetts, but shall have the same qualifications for membership as Active Fellows.

The Honorary Fellows shall be such persons as

are distinguished for their scientific and professional attainments, either as Dentists or Physicians

Active Fellows alone shall be required to pay assessments, and they alone shall be entitled to vote at meetings of the Academy

Associate and Honorary Fellows may have a voice at all meetings

Article 4. Each Fellow shall receive a properly authenticated certificate of Fellowship, with such seal, device, and inscriptions as set forth in the By-Laws

Article 5. The Constitution shall not be altered nor amended without the consent of three-fourths of the Fellows present: and every proposed alteration



or amendment shall be presented in writing at a regular meeting, and final action on the same shall not be taken until the succeeding regular meeting.

Enact. Add, after the word practitioner, in eighth line, in article three, the words - or who shall have received the proper degree at Harvard College, entitling them to the rank of a qualified Dental practitioner.

# By Laws.

## — Officers —

Article 1. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Academy, shall sign all certificates and diplomas issued, shall call special meetings, and shall perform such other duties as shall from time to time be assigned him. In the absence of the President, the duties of the office shall devolve upon the Vice-President; and in the absence of both, a President pro tem, shall be chosen.

Article 2. The Recording Secretary shall keep a record of the proceedings of all meetings of the Academy, shall notify officers when elected, and Fellows when admitted, shall

Article 3. The Corresponding Secretary shall have charge of all letters and communications addressed to the Academy, shall conduct the correspondence as may be directed by the Academy, and perform such other duties as may be assigned him.

Article 4. The Treasurer shall have the charge and general management of all moneys belonging to the Academy, keeping a correct account of all



receipts and expenditures. He shall not pay out money except by order of the President.

Article 5. The Censors shall take cognizance of all applications for Fellowship. They shall examine all the candidates in accordance with Article 3. of the Constitution, and perform such other duties as the Academy may from time to time assign them. If the examination of any candidate shall not prove satisfactory he may be re-examined at such future time as the Board of Censors may designate.

Article 6. The Librarian shall have charge of all books and other property belonging to the Academy. Keeping a correct register of the same, and

making an annual statement of the condition of his department.

Article 7. Every applicant for Fellowship shall be of sound mind, of good moral character, and be not less than twenty one years of age. He shall have received the Degree of Doctor in Medicine or such other degree as be deemed necessary or shall have pursued such a course of study or practice as shall be satisfactory to the Board of Censors.

Candidates may be examined at any meeting of the Board of Censors; and if such examination be satisfactory to the Censors, they shall report the same to the Academy at its next regular meeting where a ballot may be taken. Two thirds of the Fellows



present, voting in the affirmative shall, admit the candidate, who upon signing the Constitution, and By-Laws, and paying the admission fee, shall be entitled to all the privileges of Fellowship.

Article 8 Fees— Any person being admitted to active Fellowship shall pay the sum of five dollars. There shall be, an annual assessment of five dollars upon each Active Fellow.

Article 9 Quorum— Six Active Fellows shall constitute a quorum at any meeting of the Academy. All stated meetings of the Academy may be ordered by the President, and due notice thereof shall be given by the Secretary.

Article 3. Recording Secretary The Recording Secretary shall keep a record of the proceedings of all meetings of the Academy, shall notify officers when elected and Fellows when admitted, shall issue a notice to all the Fellows of each meeting of the Academy, and shall, in connection with the President, and Vice President, sign all certificates and diplomas issued by the Academy and shall perform such other duties as may from time to time be assigned him.

Article 6 Censors The Censors shall take cog-

From time to time, assign them. If the examinations of any candidate shall not prove satisfactory he may be re-examined at such future time as the Board of Censors may designate. They shall audit the accounts of the Treasurer; provide suitable places for meetings and transact such other business as may be referred to them by the Academy.

Article 8. Membership Every applicant for Fellowship shall be of sound mind, of good moral character, and be not less than twenty one years of age. He shall



have received the degree of Doctor in Medicine or such other degree as may be deemed necessary and shall have pursued such a course of study or practice as shall be satisfactory to The Board of Censors.

All candidates must be approved by the Board of Censors before being presented to the Academy for membership and when thus reported a ballot shall be taken. Two thirds of the Fellows present voting in the affirmative shall admit the candidate, who upon signing the Constitution, and By-Laws and paying the admission fee, shall be entitled to all the privileges of Fellowship.

Article 9. Fees. to read: Any person on being admitted to Active or Associate Fellowship shall pay the

sum of five dollars. There shall be an annual  
assessment of five dollars upon each Active and  
Associate Fellow.

Article 10. Meetings to read: Six Active and  
Associate Fellows shall constitute a quorum at any  
meeting of the Academy. The regular meetings of  
the Academy shall be holden in Boston on the  
first Tuesday evening of each month, excepting Au-  
gust, at seven o'clock unless otherwise ordered by  
the President. Special meetings may be ordered  
by the President, and due notice shall be given  
by the Secretary.

Article 11. Annual Meetings to be inserted after

The Associate Fellows shall be non-residents of New England, but shall have the same qualifications for membership as Active Fellows and shall be exempt



from annual assessments.

The Honorary Fellows shall be such persons as are distinguished for their scientific and Professional attainments, as Dentists, Physicians or Scientists, and may have a vote at all meetings.

Active and Associate Fellows shall be entitled to vote at meetings of the Academy. Only Active Fellows shall be required to pay annual assessments but all except Honorary Fellows shall pay the fee for membership.

Each Fellow shall receive, a properly authenticated certificate of Fellowship, with such seal, device and inscription as may be adopted by the Academy.

issued by the Academy, and perform such other duties as shall from time to time be assigned him.

Article 4 Corresponding Secretary - The Corresponding Secretary shall have charge of all letters and communications addressed to the Academy and shall conduct the correspondence as may be directed by the Academy. He shall notify all members of their elections, committees of their appointment, and the subjects referred to them. Keep the manuscript Constitution, and By-Laws of the Academy. Keep a record of the membership, including resignations and other changes. Render a report with reference of the same at the annual meeting and perform such other duties as may from time to time be assigned him.

## Article 2. Constitution

Section 1 Officers - The officers of the Academy shall  
consist of a President Vice President, Recording Secretary  
Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer Librarian and an Executive  
Committee of three, who shall be elected annually and  
hold office until their successors are chosen.

Section 2 The officers of the Academy shall constitute  
a Council

### Article 3 Constitution

Section 1 Membership - The Academy shall consist of Active, Associate, and Honorary members who shall be styled Fellows.

Section 2 The Active Fellows shall be residents of New England who shall have received a recognized medical or dental degree from a college in good standing.

Section 3 The Associate Fellows shall be non residents of New England but shall have in this respect the same qualifications for membership as Active Fellows.

Section 4 The Honorary Fellows shall be such persons as are distinguished for their scientific and professional attainments as Dentists, Physicians or Scientists.

### Article 5 Constitution



Section 1. Elections - All elections shall be by ballot.

Section 2 A two thirds vote of those present at any regular meeting shall be necessary to elect either Active Associate or Honorary Fellows.

Section 3 In election of officers, the two names receiving the greatest number of votes shall be nominated in case of failure to elect at the first ballot, and a majority of all votes cast shall be necessary to a choice.

### Article 6 Amendments

Section 1. All proposed changes in or amendments to this constitution shall be in writing, presented at a regular meeting, signed by three Active or Associate Fellows and such proposed alteration or amendment shall not be acted upon until the next regular meeting.

### By - Laws Amended -

#### Article 1 - Duties of Officers -

Section 1. President - The President shall preside at  
all meetings of the Academy and Council. He shall  
give a deciding vote in all cases of a tie, except in  
elections of officers; call special meetings at his dis-  
cretion, or upon the written request of three Active  
members; sign all certificates and diplomas issued  
and perform such other duties as shall from time to  
time be assigned him

Section 4 Corresponding Secretary The Corresponding

Secretary shall have charge of all letters and communications addressed to the Academy, and shall conduct the correspondence as may be directed by the Academy. He shall notify all members, and Officers of their elections, commissions of their appointment, and the subjects referred to them; keep the manuscript Constitution, By-Laws and Code of Ethics of the Academy. Keep a record of the membership including resignations and other changes; superintend the printing for the Academy, and report in reference to the same at the annual meeting and perform such other duties as shall from time to time be assigned him.

Section 5 Treasurer - The Treasurer shall collect all dues keep an exact account of all receipts, and expenditures

and the vouchers therefor notify all members of  
arranges and read a written report of the conditions  
of his official affairs together with the number of  
members in absentia, at the annual meeting, or on order  
of the Academy, and shall pay out money only on order  
of the President, countersigned by the Recording Secretary.

Section 7 Executive Committee - The Executive  
Committee shall provide proper places for all meetings  
of the Academy, and arrange for papers and other  
scientific and professional matter for annual and  
all regular meetings. examine into the moral and  
professional standing of candidates for membership and  
if no objection to the candidate is found upon the  
same at the next regular meeting to that at which  
the candidate was proposed. They shall audit the



accounts of the Treasurer.

Section 8 Council - The Council shall constitute a court for the trial of members for the violation of the Laws or Ethics of the Academy. Charges against a member shall be made in writing, addressed to the President. He on receiving them, shall call a meeting of the Council to investigate the same, and the evidence thereof. If a majority of the Council, after such investigation shall be of the opinion that the charges are prima facie well founded, they shall serve a copy of them on the accused, and appoint a day for hearing his defence, of which day he and the party making the charges shall have at least ten days notice, and if the accused in person or by counsel.

who shall be an Active Fellow of the Academy,  
having had a fair opportunity to hear the evidence  
against him, and to make his defence, shall be  
found guilty by a two thirds vote of the Council  
they shall so report to the Academy at its next  
regular meeting when the Academy shall determine  
the penalty, be it a reprimand, suspension or ex-  
pulsion, which shall be decided by a two-thirds  
vote of the members present. If after due  
notification, the accused party, or council shall  
fail to appear at the time or place of trial  
without satisfactory excuse rendered at the time,  
he shall be considered as admitting the truth  
of the charges against him, and shall be  
liable to sentence accordingly.

Article 2. — Duties and Privileges of Members.

Section 1. Active Fellows shall, on election sign the Constitution ~~and~~ By-Laws and Code of Ethics, pay an admission fee of five dollars, and at each annual meeting thereafter a due of five dollars, and they only shall have the right to vote and hold office.

Section 2 — Associate Fellows shall on election sign the Constitution, By-Laws and Code of Ethics, pay an admission fee of five dollars and shall be entitled to all the privileges of the floor at regular meetings.

Section 3 Honorary Fellows shall be entitled to the privileges of the floor at regular meetings.

Article 3. — Admission of Members.

Applications for membership shall be endorsed by two

Active or Associate Fellows in good standing. The Committee having reported (art. 1 Sec 7) the name of the candidate shall be printed on the notice of the next regular meeting, and he shall be balloted for at the next meeting.

#### Article 4. Appropriations

The moneys of the Academy shall not be appropriated without a two thirds vote of the members present.

#### Article 5. Meetings

Section 2 Annual Meeting of the Academy shall be holden in Boston on the first Monday in November at three o'clock P. M. for the election of officers, and for the transactions of such business



as may promote the welfare of the Academy

### Article 7- Order of Business

1. Reading of the records of the previous meeting
2. Report of the Executive Committee and other officers
3. Election of Fellows
4. Reports of Committees
5. Papers or addresses
6. Subject for the evening.
7. Discussion of the same

## Article 8 Rules of Order.

Section 1 Any member who may speak on any subject or questions before the Academy shall rise and address his remarks to the Chair.

Section 2 Any member called to order while speaking shall take his seat, and the debate be suspended until the point of order is settled.

Section 3 All questions of order shall be decided by the Chair, subject to an appeal, which shall be determined by a vote, without debate.

Section 4 All Resolutions and Amendments shall be offered in writing.

Section 5 Any member may call for a division of a question when the same will admit of it.

Section 6 All questions not provided for by

These rules shall be determined by Parliamentary  
usage, as set forth in Cushing's Manual.

### Article 9.

All proposed changes in or amendments to these  
By-Laws shall be in writing, presented at a  
regular meeting, signed by three Active or  
Associate Fellows, and such alterations or  
amendments shall not be voted upon until  
the next regular meeting, and shall be  
adopted only by a three fourths vote of the members  
present.

— Article One —

## Duties of the Profession to their Patients.

Section 1. The dentist should fully recognize the obligations involved in the discharge of his duty towards his patients. As they are in most cases unable to correctly estimate the character of his operations, his own sense of right must guarantee faithfulness in their performance.

Section 2. The dentist should lend his influence to encourage a sound dental, and medical education and to uphold in the community correct views of the powers and the limitations of dental science and art. It is not to be expected that the patient will possess a very extended or accurate knowledge of professional matters.

The dentist should make due allowance for



this, patiently explaining many things which may seem quite clear to himself.

He should encourage no false hopes, by promising success, when, in the nature of the case, there is an uncertainty.

## Article Two

### Maintaining Professional Character

Section 1 In his relation with other dental practitioners and his patients, the dentist should be governed by strict rules of honor and courtesy. His conduct should be such as, if universally imitated, would insure the mutual confidence of all dental practitioners.

Section 2 The professional success of a practitioner

depends upon qualities connected with his moral character, his scientific attainments, and also his industry and business talents.

But the relation of practitioners of dentistry to patients is not like that of tradesmen to their customers. The kind of competition which might be considered honorable in business cannot exist between dentists without diminishing their usefulness, and lowering the standing of the dental profession.

Section 3 If a dentist treats a patient during the temporary absence or illness of the usual dentist or in case of accident or other emergency, he should direct that the patient go to the former as soon as he is able to take charge of the case, and then should relinquish it to him.

Section 4 It is unprofessional to resort to  
Public advertisements, cards, hand-bills, posters  
or signs calling attention to peculiar styles of work  
tenders of prices, or special modes of operating, or to  
claim superiority over neighboring practitioners,  
to publish reports of cases or certificates in public  
prints, to go from house to house to solicit or perform  
operations, to circulate or recommend testimonials or  
to perform any similar act.

Section 5 Consultation should be encouraged in  
cases of unusual responsibility or doubt. A  
consultation is called for the benefit of the patient,  
and to give him the advantage of collective skill.  
Should there be a difference of opinion, discussion  
should be temperate and always confidential.

A consulting dentist should be careful to say  
or do nothing to impair the confidence of the  
patient or his family in the attending dentist.
