AK's Multi-gun Sim 360 General Rules

Safety

This is a firearms simulator competition where no live fire ammunition is used. This allows us to take liberty with creating a course of fire that goes out of the normal 180 degree bounds of a live-fire competition. Do NOT use the 360 degree rules in this simulator competition for a live-fire competition. Know the rules of any competition, before you participate in that competition. We will provide the understanding and safety grounding while you participate in this unique 360 degree competition experience, but live-fire range safety rules need to be adhered to in competitions outside of this simulator competition. Our firearms simulator provides a great opportunity to learn how to move safely with a firearm, and much of what you learn can be used to enhance your live-fire competition skills. This is not offensive training, it is not force-on-force nor is it law enforcement or military training. We utilize standard NRA Range Safety Rules.

What makes our Sim 360 Competitions different.

Push your limits SAFELY. We value shooting accuracy and firearms safety over speed. Our competition rules reward accuracy and safety, and disfavor pushing to the point of losing control which seems to push the limits with some IPSC, IDPA-like competitions. We want this experience to be a FUN and useful experience for you. Although many of these skills will be transferable to real life, and it may feel like tactical training, understand this is a competition and **not** defensive tactical training.

AK's Simulator Multi-gun Sim 360 League Teams & Ongoing Scoring Overview

- 1) Teams will consist of 4 team members and must show up at the same time/date. If a team has more than 5 members but less than 8, only top 4 scores from the team will be counted toward the overall team standing.
- 2) Teams will choose a team name that is fun, relevant and not offensive.
- 3) Teams will have team scores, and each individual team member will have an individual score.
- 4) If an individual participates more than once, on separate days, only the highest overall individual score will be retained for the INDIVIDUAL on the on-line leaderboard. Team scores for a particular do not change on the leader board unless that team competes more than once, then the overall better team scoring will move to the leader board.
- 5) Teams have private events that score publicly against other private teams, so all teams do not need to participate at the same time for scoring, and prizes except for play offs and championships. Event work best if between 4-6 people compete at a time.
- 6) In the event of a tie for the 4 major stages, team or individual, Uncle Joe's Shotgun Fantasy stage will be used as a 5th tie breaking stage.
- 7) Prior team scores and regional challenge will be formally announced during National Shooting Sports Month in August of 2021. Teams and scores will be published on our website.
- 8) If a team wants to improve their standing, they just need to come in as a team and do the shoots again.
- 9) During National Shooting Sports Month, event sponsors may donate prizes to participants and competition leaders. Prizes constantly change.

League Categories (Choose One Team Category, One Personal Category)

Team/Individual Categories:

Modern Family (Minors to Seniors, Female and Male)

Average Jake (Minors to Seniors, Men Only)

Average Annies (Minors to Seniors Ladies Only)

Crazy Cat Ladies (Senior Ladies Only 60+)

Grand Torino (Senior Men Only 60+)

Die Harders (Men Experienced Competitors or LE Only, Any Age)

Sarah Connor (Women Experienced Competitors or LE Only, Any Age)

Notes:

Teams should choose a league that covers all the competitors on their team. Modern Family is the most popular.

Individuals should choose the category that they want to be judged as an individual, under. For example, an experienced female competitor over 60, may want to choose the Sarah Connor territory, even if it is not specific to seniors over 60. However, if a lady over 60 is less experienced and prefers not to be judged against experienced competitors, she can choose the “Crazy Cat Lady” category.
