Tactical data links (TDLs) are the unique military communications that allow warfighters to share a common picture of their battlespace - the position of the friendlies, the position of the enemy, and who's doing what to whom

"Timber Sweet" is the brevity code word for a functional Link-16 network



The TIMBER SWEET narrative...

- Told by data link people themselves, in their own words.
- 5 main characters "week-in-the-life" of a JICO, fighter pilot, JTAC, systems engineer, data link program manager;
- Dozen cameo players "sea stories" from an AWACS combat controller, infantry signals officer, military historian, battle watch captain, data link instructor, field artillery commander, US senator, fire control technician, famed JICOs, systems engineers and program managers.


Features of TIMBER SWEET...

- Tactical data links are international, and so is this film;
- History, present-day, and future;
- Military action and gee-wiz technology;
- But mostly... TIMBER SWEET is about "data link warriors" and their amazing exploits...

...engineers who design the systems, program managers who get them fielded, the link experts who control the networks, and front-line warfighters who use the data to kill the enemy.

TIMBER SWEET messages, themes, subplots...

- What are tactical data links and why do we have them?
- Critically important, but little-known outside of the community;
- Natural evolution of military tactical communications going back thousands of years;
- REALLY difficult and complex;
- Smart, well-trained, motivated people are more important than technology.



TIMBER SWEET is engaging, fast-paced, humorous, and people-driven;

Not a training film - technical detail used sparingly and only to make a point;

Not a marketing pitch or advertisement - it presents both the goods and the "others" of the data link story;

TIMBER SWEET will inform, motivate and entertain!

- Persons directly connected to engineering, communications, and defense systems through employment or military service;

How will TIMBER SWEET be seen?

Funding of TIMBER SWEET....

Primary challenges...

- FUNDING: We need the defense industry and others to come to the table and sponsor this film;
- ACCESS: We need governments, the military, and industry to allow access for interviews and job-shadowing;
- SCOPE: The story of tactical data links is large and deep, and TIMBER SWEET will need to capture the essence of it in just 54-minutes of screen time;
