COVID-19 REOPENING PLAN

Date and Hours

Proposed Reopening:

Thursday July 2, 2020 from 3pm to 8pm

Friday July 3, 2020 from 3pm to 8pm

Saturday July 4, 2020 from 3pm to 3pm

Initial plan is to operate from Thursday to Saturday in the following weeks in compliance with Provincial and Municipal regulations with regular reviews by the executive.

Prior to reopening, the Legion's cleaning staff will conduct a full cleaning of the facility, including disinfecting of all high touch areas.

Physical Layout

Patio – see attached schedule to patio extension application

Picnic tables will be moved from the existing patio to the extended patio area and will be situated to provide for required distancing between tables and for service. All picnic tables will be covered with heavy plastic to enable effective disinfecting between sittings. Some small indoor bar tables will be relocated to the existing patio area again in compliance with social distancing requirements.

In accordance with current legislation, the total number of patrons in the patio area at any time will not exceed 50 and will be monitored by the Bar Steward ("BS").

Patio Entrance

There will be one outdoor entrance to the patio area at which will be a registration table and greeter to ensure all members sign in with their guests and provide phone numbers for any contact tracing that may be required. There will be written instructions on the protocols in place at the Legion and hand sanitizing will be required at that time.

Bar Services

BS will be equipped with disposable gloves, masks and/or face shields for use at all times. Frequent hand washing and disinfecting of high touch areas will be performed on a regular basis. All staff and volunteers will be instructed on the proper use of personal protective equipment and other safe service requirements.

There will be no bar service inside the facility. Orders will be taken by the BS tableside and delivered to the table for cash payment. No draft will be served and no glassware utilized. All drinks will be served in disposable plastic glasses.

Washroom Facilities

Hand sanitizer and disposable masks will be provided at the entrance to the Club room, as well as the men's and women's washrooms, for use by patrons. Only one patron will be permitted in each washroom at one time. Directional signs and floor markings will be clearly visible. Washrooms will be disinfected on a regular basis, at least every hour, in accordance with Provincial guidelines.
